Container marked, "number three" contains scrapings and shavings from the floor, which have a reddish colored stain under a brown paint and which were obtained directly in front of and to the left of the heating vent mentioned in referenced airtel.

Container marked, "number four" contains samples of floor shavings and scrapings which is painted brown for test purposes.

If blood, further determine if they are human blood. If human blood is detected, will conduct the same investigation as requested in referenced airtel.

The Laboratory is further requested to use the shaving and scraping samples contained in containers "number two" and "number four" for test purposes.

Enclosed herewith for the FBI Laboratory is one pill box containing scrapings from a heating vent, which are believed to be blood stains.

Transmitted, under separate cover, is one heating vent from which above enclosed scrapings were obtained and which vent contains other stains believed to be blood.

For the information of the FBI Laboratory, over the past 16 months, 15 black children in the Atlanta area ranging in ages from 7 to 15, have been abducted and/or murdered. Eleven of these children have been located murdered and four are still missing. Two of the 15 children are females and 13 are males.

The enclosed pill box, containing above-described scrapings, and the heating vent being submitted under separate cover, were obtained from Apartment #9, 890 West End Avenue, Atlanta. This was the residence of Anthony Bernard Carter, black; male; dob 8/31/70; reported missing 7/6/80; found murdered on 7/7/80; cause of death determined to be multiple stab wounds of the back and chest.

Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI), Division of Forensic Sciences, report dated 7/15/80, case #80-15919, regarding Anthony Carter, reveals two test tubes containing blood which was submitted by investigating officer for examination with the request of BA blood alcohol. Results were positive for ethyl alcohol, 0.15 grams. Results were noted as unreliable, due to putrefaction.

██████████ Technician, GBI, Division of Forensic Sciences, has advised that when blood samples of Carter were received, samples were in extreme state of putrefaction and therefore, could not type. She also advised that no swatches from Carter's blood samples were prepared. *b7c*

The FBI Laboratory is requested to examine the enclosed scrapings and also the stains on the heating vent, which is being submitted under separate cover, to determine if these stains are blood. If determined to be blood, determine if it is human blood. Conduct ABD Grouping, Rh, MN and enzyme typing systems, if determined to be human blood.

The Atlanta office will conduct logical investigation through school, birth, etc., records in an effort to locate medical records and blood types for Anthony B. Carter.

Forwarded to the FBI Laboratory under separate cover are two lengths of brown electrical cord and two needle-nose pliers.

For the information of the FBI Laboratory and Identification Division, on 3/4/80, Angela Lanier was last observed at school and on 3/10/80, the body of Angela Lanier was found in a wooded area less than one mile from her residence. When the body was found, the hands were bound with the brown cord, labeled #1. The medical examiner stated that Lanier was alive for several days after her disappearance and that she was bound with the brown cord prior to her murder. The cord was cut in one location, by the medical examiner, to remove it from the body. It is also noted that the medical examiner's office and the Atlanta Police Department (APD) did not preserve the cord for latent fingerprint examinations.

During July, 1980, [REDACTED] black male, DOB [REDACTED] SSAN [REDACTED] was arrested by the APD. [REDACTED] had attempted to abduct a ten year old black male at a location one block from where Lanier's body

had been found. In addition, on the same day, [REDACTED] was observed in the same neighborhood watching a young black female as she swept the back porch of her residence. *b7c*

At the time of his arrest, [REDACTED] was wearing hospital pajamas and was using a brown electrical cord as a belt. The enclosed cord, labeled #2, is the cord obtained by the APD from [REDACTED] at the time of his arrest. *b7c*

The interview of [REDACTED] determined that [REDACTED] repairs old televisions and has numerous electrical cords at his residence. The November 5th telegram to President Carter from Atlanta Mayor Maynard Jackson regarding the incidents involving 15 black children in Atlanta which you referred to the Department of Justice, ID 080383, was forwarded to FBI Headquarters.

On November 6th the Attorney General instructed the FBI to initiate a preliminary investigation to determine whether four black children missing in Atlanta are being held in violation of the Federal Kidnaping Statute. This investigation was launched at the request of Atlanta Mayor Jackson and Public Safety Commissioner Lee Brown. It is believed, therefore, that it would be more appropriate for Mayor Jackson to receive a response from the White House.







Forwarded to the FBI Laboratory under separate cover are two lengths of brown electrical cord and two needle-nose pliers.

For the information of the FBI Laboratory and Identification Division, on 3/4/80, Angela Lanier was last observed at school and on 3/10/80, the body of Angela Lanier was found in a wooded area less than one mile from her residence. When the body was found, the hands were bound with the brown cord, labeled #1. The medical examiner stated that Lanier was alive for several days after her disappearance and that she was bound with the brown cord prior to her murder. The cord was cut in one location by the medical examiner, to remove it from the body. It is also noted that the medical examiner's office and the Atlanta Police Department (APD) did not preserve the cord for latent fingerprint examinations.

b7c During July, 1980, [redacted] black male, DOB [redacted], SSAN [redacted] was arrested by the APD. [redacted] had attempted to abduct a ten year old black male at a location one block from where Lanier's body

had been found. In addition, on the same day, [REDACTED] was observed in the same neighborhood watching a young black female as she swept the back porch of her residence.
