



A SPECIAL TASK FORCE COMPRISED OF OFFICERS FROM THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT (APD) AND GEORGIA BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (GBI) AGENTS HAS BEEN FORMED TO INVESTIGATE THESE MURDERS. THE ATLANTA DIVISION HAS COVERED NUMEROUS LEADS OUTSIDE THE STATE OF GEORGIA AND OTHER FACILITIES OF THE FBI HAVE BEEN MADE AVAILABLE TO AID IN THE INVESTIGATION.

ON NOVEMBER 6, 1980, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AUTHORIZED A PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION BY THE FBI TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE FOUR MISSING BLACK CHILDREN ARE BEING HELD IN VIOLATION OF TITLE 18, U. S. CODE, SECTION 1201 (KIDNAPING).

RETEL REQUESTED ADDITIONAL MANPOWER TO AUGMENT THE SPECIAL AGENT COMPLEMENT OF THE ATLANTA DIVISION TO ASSIST IN THIS INVESTIGATION.

CHARLOTTE AND MEMPHIS DIVISIONS ARE DIRECTED TO FURNISH TWO SPECIAL AGENTS FOR THIS INVESTIGATION. THE COLUMBIA AND MOBILE DIVISIONS WILL EACH FURNISH ONE SPECIAL AGENT. EACH OFFICE, CHARLOTTE, MEMPHIS, COLUMBIA AND MOBILE WILL FURNISH A BUREAU VEHICLE. THESE SPECIAL AGENTS WILL REPORT FOR DUTY IN THE

ATLANTA DIVISION BY 8:00 A.M., MONDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 1980.

THE SPECIAL AGENTS CHOSEN FROM YOUR OFFICE FOR THIS ASSIGNMENT SHOULD BE A SELF-MOTIVATED, MATURE INVESTIGATOR, AND IF POSSIBLE, EXPERIENCED IN HOMICIDE AND/OR SEX-RELATED OFFENSES AND FAMILIAR WITH THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA. THE AGENT MUST NOT BE THE SUBJECT OF RECENT SEVERE ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION NOR BE ON PROBATION.

MEMORANDUM FOR WILLIAM H. WEBSTER,
DIRECTOR, FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

During the past fifteen months, fifteen black children have disappeared in Atlanta, Georgia. Eleven of those children have been found dead, one most recently over the last weekend. While I am aware of the support already being provided Atlanta officials by the Bureau in their attempt to solve these deaths and disappearances, I have concluded that a higher level of federal involvement is now appropriate.

More specifically, I am now authorizing and requesting that the Bureau initiate immediately a preliminary investigation, predicated on 18 U.S.C. 1201, to determine whether the four missing black children are being held in violation of the federal kidnapping law. In connection with that investigation, it is my expectation that the Bureau will, of necessity, be required to examine the circumstances surrounding the disappearances of the eleven children whose bodies have been recovered. You are authorized to devote whatever resources you deem appropriate, in addition to those presently assigned to this matter, to ensure that the investigation is conducted in an expeditious yet thorough fashion. FBI efforts in this regard should be designed, however, not to supplant or duplicate but rather to supplement and reinforce the local investigation.

Forwarded to the FBI Laboratory under separate cover are two lengths of brown electrical cord and two needle-nose pliers.

For the information of the FBI Laboratory and Identification Division, on 3/4/80, Angela Lanier was last observed at school and on 3/10/80, the body of Angela Lanier was found in a wooded area less than one mile from her residence. When the body was found, the hands were bound with the brown cord, labeled #1. The medical examiner stated that Lanier was alive for several days after her disappearance and that she was bound with the brown cord prior to her murder. The cord was cut in one location, by the medical examiner, to remove it from the body. It is also noted that the medical examiner's office and the Atlanta Police Department (APD) did not preserve the cord for latent fingerprint examinations.

During July, 1980, [REDACTED], black male, DOB [REDACTED] SSAN [REDACTED] was arrested by the APD. [REDACTED] had attempted to abduct a ten year old black male at a location one block from where Lanier's body

had been found. In addition, on the same day, [REDACTED] was observed in the same neighborhood watching a young black female as she swept the back porch of her residence.

At the time of his arrest, [REDACTED] was wearing hospital pajamas and was using a brown electrical cord as a belt. The enclosed cord, labeled #2, is the cord obtained by the APD from [REDACTED] at the time of his arrest.

The interview of [REDACTED] determined that [REDACTED] repairs old televisions and has numerous electrical cords at his residence. On 12/4/80, [REDACTED] furnished to SA [REDACTED] two needle-nose pliers from his tool chest. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] would have access to both his tool chest and any electrical cords he had in their residence. b7c

PURPOSE: To apprise you of the results of an evaluation by myself and SA [redacted] of Atlanta request for Investigative Support Information System (ISIS) support for captioned case. *b7c*

DETAILS: I was in the Atlanta Field Office with SA [redacted] Software Operational Support Unit, 12/3-5/80, to evaluate Atlanta's request for ISIS support for the ATKID investigation, which involves the murder of a number of children in the Atlanta area. There have been 11 children murdered and four are still missing. Of the 11 murdered children that have been found, eight appear to be unrelated homicides. The other three initially appeared to be somewhat related. Further investigation, however, has suggested that they may also be unrelated. *b7c*

The Atlanta Field Office has control of the information that has been developed in this case from both an administrative and investigative standpoint. Each murder and missing child is being investigated by a two-man FBI team. The investigative data has been sub-filed by victim/missing child. The volume of data currently consists of approximately two case volumes per victim/missing child. It is projected that volume may reach four case volumes per victim/missing child in 30 days.

The findings of our evaluation are that ISIS support, either online or offline, for this case is not warranted at this time. SAC and investigative personnel of the Atlanta Field Office concurred with this conclusion. The case is manageable regarding volume, each case by itself is not complex and the cases, for the most part, appear to be unrelated. SAC, Atlanta, will closely monitor this investigation. In 30 days he will reevaluate Atlanta's position and determine if the information volume and complexity of the case are still manageable. At that time, if offline ISIS support appears to be warranted, Atlanta will then request same.
