THE PURPOSE OF THIS COMMUNICATION IS TO ADVISE THE BUREAU OF CURRENT INVESTIGATIVE DIRECTION OF CAPTIONED MAJOR CASE, AND TO REQUEST TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT OF TEN ADDITIONAL SPECIAL AGENTS TO ATLANTA TO ASSIST IN THIS INVESTIGATION.

CURRENTLY, ATLANTA HAS 24 SPECIAL AGENTS ASSIGNED ON A FULL-TIME BASIS TO ATKID. EIGHT OF THESE AGENTS ARE FROM OTHER DIVISIONS, ASSIGNED ON A TEMPORARY BASIS TO ATLANTA; NINE ARE FORMER ATLANTA FIRST-OFFICE AGENTS WHOSE TRANSFERS TO OTHER DIVISIONS HAVE BEEN DELAYED; AND SEVEN ARE AGENTS SUPPLIED FROM PERMANENT ATLANTA DIVISION COMPLIMENT.

WHEN INVESTIGATION INITIATED AT ATLANTA, INDIVIDUAL HOMICIDES AND MISSING CHILDREN CASES WERE ASSIGNED TO SPECIFIC AGENTS. EACH

PAGE TWO AT (7A-1835) UNCLAS

INDIVIDUAL CASE HAS BEEN THOROUGHLY INVESTIGATED WITH PARENTAL OR PEER SUSPECTS DEVELOPED IN FOUR; THE PROBABILITY EXISTING THAT THE REMAINING THIRTEEN HOMICIDES AND DISAPPEARANCE BEING THE RESULT OF ONE OR MORE MULTIPLE VICTIM SUBJECT(S). THEREFORE, BASED UPON DATA PROVIDED BY THE BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE UNIT, QUANTICO, AND INVESTIGATION AT ATLANTA, ATLANTA DIVISION RESTRUCTURED DIRECTION OF INVESTIGATION CONCENTRATE INVESTIGATIVE EFFORTS IN ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY INDIVIDUAL(S) RESPONSIBLE FOR MULTIPLE HOMICIDES.

THIS PROACTIVE INVESTIGATION IS AS FOLLOWS:

FOUR SPECIAL AGENTS ARE ASSIGNED WITH DOG AND DOG HANDLER PROVIDED BY KNOXVILLE DIVISION TO SEARCH WOODED AREAS FOR TWO CHILDREN STILL MISSING. IT IS NOTED THAT ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 6, 1981, A THIRD CHILD, PATRICK BALTAZAR, WAS REPORTED MISSING UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES SIMILAR TO THOSE INVOLVED IN ATKID, AND MAY BE ADDED TO LIST OF MISSING CHILDREN IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

ELEVEN SPECIAL AGENTS ARE DIVIDED INTO TWO TEAMS WHO ARE ASSIGNED FULL-TIME TO SUSPECT ELIMINATION. ATLANTA HAS PREVIOUSLY OBTAINED COMPUTERIZED DATA REGARDING ALL SEXUAL OFFENDERS WITHIN THE STATE OF GEORGIA WITHIN THE PAST FIVE YEARS, AND HAS REVIEWED ALL METROPOLITAN ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT RECORDS PERTAINING TO

ARRESTS OF SEX OFFENSES AND ASSAULTS AGAINST MINORS. THESE POTENTIAL SUSPECTS HAVE NOW BEEN NARROWED DOWN TO 650 INDIVIDUALS, WHO THE SUSPECT ELIMINATION TEAMS ARE CHARGED WITH FURTHER INVESTIGATING.

SIX SPECIAL AGENTS ARE ASSIGNED TO COVER LEADS GENERATED WITHIN ATLANTA, FROM OTHER DIVISIONS, AND FROM TIPS. FURTHERMORE, THEY ARE CONTINUING INVESTIGATION INTO FOUR APPARENTLY UNRELATED HOMICIDES AND ARE ASSIGNED SPECIFIC PROACTIVE INVESTIGATION PERTAINING TO THE APPARENTLY RELATED CASES. THIS PROACTIVE INVESTIGATION INCLUDES SURVEILLANCE OF PORNOGRAPHIC BOOK STORES AND MOVIES, CANVASSING AND SURVEILLANCE OF HOMOSEXUAL BARS AND AREAS FREQUENTED BY MALE PROSTITUTES AND DEVELOPMENT OF INFORMANTS WITH KNOWLEDGE OF CHILD PROSTITUTION.

WITH THE DISAPPEARANCE OF LUBIE GETER ON JANUARY 3, 1981, THE DISCOVERY OF THE BODY OF TERRY LORENZO PUE ON JANUARY 23, 1981 AND THE DISCOVERY OF THE BODY OF LUBIE GETER ON FEBRUARY 5, 1981, THE INVESTIGATIVE RESOURCES ASSIGNED TO ATKID HAVE, BY NECESSITY, BEEN REACTIVE IN NATURE AND THE PROACTIVE INVESTIGATION DESCRIBED ABOVE HAS BEEN HELD IN ABEYANCE. EACH NEW DISAPPEARANCE, INCLUDING BALTAZAR ON FEBRUARY 6, 1981, AND THE DISCOVERY OF EACH BODY,

REQUIRES MASSIVE COMMITMENTS OF INVESTIGATIVE RESOURCES TO THE DETRIMENT OF SUSTAINED PROACTIVE INVESTIGATION. EACH SUCH INCIDENT NECESSITATES ORGANIZING AND CONDUCTING CRIME SCENE SEARCHES, EXTENSIVE NEIGHBORHOODS AND IN DEPTH INVESTIGATION INTO THE ACTIVITIES OF THE NEW VICTIM.

IT IS ATLANTA'S OPINION THAT BARRING AN UNPREDICTABLE BREAK IN THIS CASE, THE SOLUTION WILL ONLY BE THE RESULT OF SUSTAINED PROACTIVE INVESTIGATION RELATING TO SUSPECTS DEVELOPED THROUGH ELIMINATION OF KNOWN OFFENDERS, PLANNED INVESTIGATION IN AREAS FREQUENTED BY SEXUAL DEVIANTS AND SURVEILLANCES OF SELECTED HIGH-RISK AREAS FREQUENTED BY FORMER VICTIMS.

IT IS REQUESTED OF THE BUREAU THAT 10 ADDITIONAL SAS BE ASSIGNED THIS SPECIAL WITH CONSIDERATION TO SELECTION OF AS MANY AS POSSIBLE FROM OP LIST. HOWEVER, THEY SHOULD REPORT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE WITHOUT NORMAL 30-DAY REPORTING. IF ATLANTA'S REQUEST FOR TEN ADDITIONAL AGENTS IS GRANTED, THESE AGENTS WILL BE DEDICATED TO THE PROACTIVE INVESTIGATION OUTLINED ABOVE.

IF THIS REQUEST IS GRANTED, IT IS ALSO REQUESTED THAT SEVEN ADDITIONAL BUCARS BE PROVIDED ATLANTA FROM OTHER DIVISION.

ATLANTA HAS PREVIOUSLY REQUESTED ISIS COMPUTER FROM THE BUREAU TO AID IN THIS INVESTIGATION, AND THIS REQUEST IS CURRENTLY UNDER CONSIDERATION. ADDITIONALLY, ATLANTA HAS PREVIOUSLY REQUESTED FOUR MORE SUPPORT PERSONNEL TO BE ASSIGNED ON A PERMANENT BASIS



To advise of travel by Visual Information Specialist [redacted] Special Projects Section, Laboratory Division, to Atlanta to interview a witness under hypnosis for the purpose of preparing an artist's conception drawing.

DETAILS:

On 2/17/81, at the request of the Atlanta Office, Visual Information Specialist [redacted] Special Projects Section, Laboratory Division, traveled to Atlanta and on the morning of 2/18/81 with SA [redacted] Atlanta Division and Dr. [redacted] interviewed [redacted] a 16-year-old, black male had been forced into a car by an unknown black male wearing a police or guard-type uniform. Victim was driven around Atlanta and when car stopped at a red light, [redacted] opened door and escaped. Under hypnosis, [redacted] gave a detailed description of the Unsub and from this description Visual Information Specialist [redacted] prepared an artist's conception drawing. The witness said the drawing looked very much like the man who had grabbed him.

Later that same date, [redacted] interviewed [redacted] who had seen an unknown white male in a parked car near where later that day the body of a black child who had been murdered was found. From this interview, an artist's conception drawing of the person she had seen was prepared.

On 2/19/81, with SA [redacted] Atlanta Division, Visual Information Specialist [redacted] met with [redacted] a 14-year-old black male who claims to have seen one of the children who had been found murdered getting into a car with an unknown black male. From the description furnished by [redacted] an artist's conception drawing was made of this Unsub.
