The "New York Post" on 6/7/63, in a story concerning the notorious British prostitute, Christine Keeler, stated, "It was reported that information had been forwarded to the FBI on the possibility that American diplomats or politicians may have been compromised. This is not true."

Legat has arranged to be informed if anything of this nature develops.

This is being checked

Only two US angles have arisen to date. First, Dr. Stephen Ward, the osteopath in whose apartment Keeler was entertaining, is reported to have received his osteopathic degree from a US college prior to World War II. Secondly, the London "Daily Telegraph" of 6/10/63 quotes Admiral R. B. Lynch, US Naval Attache in London, as saying, "If Ivanov was a spy he certainly fooled me." Ivanov is the Soviet Military Attache who shared Keeler's favors. Admiral Lynch reportedly stated he had met Ivanov a number of times on the diplomatic cocktail circuit.

General Joseph Carroll, former Bureau Agent and present head of the Defense Intelligence Agency, has informed us that Defense Secretary McNamara is extremely interested in the Keeler case and has asked to be kept promptly informed of all developments. General Carroll asked that we furnish him any data of defense interest which may be forwarded by our Legat.

Pursuant to instructions ASAC Welte, Chicago, was advised by telephone 6/11/63 to check out the press item appearing in the Washington Star 6/10/63 concerning Dr. Stephen Ward. This item stated that the American Osteopathic Association, Chicago, Illinois, reported their records show a Stephen Ward graduated in 1938 from the Kirksville, Missouri, College of Osteopathy in surgery but that he does not belong to the American Association and has practiced osteopathy only in England.

Welte was cautioned that the Bureau must not be identified as taking an active interest in this matter and that he should attempt, through his reliable sources, to secure independent verification of the facts alleged in the press. He was instructed that if he is unable to secure this information without identifying his interest he should telephone the appropriate office covering the Kirksville College and ask them to verify Ward's graduation. It was emphasized that the FBI must not be identified in any inquiry and that any facts secured should be immediately furnished to the Bureau.

Our Chicago Office reports that the 1959 yearbook of the American Osteopathic Association, 212 East Ohio Street, Chicago, does not list Ward as a member but contains a listing captioned "Nonmembers of the American Osteopathic Association." This list includes the name Stephen T. Ward, 38 Devonshire Street, W.1, London, England. This Ward is listed as a member of the class of 1938 at the Kirksville, Missouri, College of Osteopathy and Surgery. No further information is listed and neither Ward's middle initial nor the listed address has appeared in press stories currently available. We have refrained from making open inquiry at the college in order to avoid any possibility that the U.S. press might learn of our interest. There is no identifiable reference to Ward in our indices. *8-1*

Legal Attache (Legat) Bates at London reported that US Embassy records in London indicate Thomas Corbally talked with the Ambassador's secretary on 1/29/63 and furnished information concerning the association of London prostitute Christine Keeler with former British War Minister Profumo and a "Soviet." This was allegedly done because Corbally felt Keeler might make a trip to the US. The Director asked if we knew what disposition the Embassy had made of this information.

We do not know what the Embassy did, but we do know that they did not tell us and we are cabling Legat, London, to find out whether the Embassy told anyone.

In addition, we are asking Legat, London, whether he feels this case can be adequately covered during his scheduled absence for 3-day conferences at the Seat of Government commencing 7/8/63, and for the two weeks annual leave he plans to take in the US thereafter.





Eyes of U.S. Were Upon Ward

London, June 10 (Special)—U. S. authorities for weeks had been shadowing Dr. Stephen Ward as a Communist suspect who they thought was meeting too many Americans—and they played a big part in unmasking him as a vice ring operator, sources said today.

The U. S. officials also aided Scotland Yard in pressing its investigation of whether the call girl ring Ward has been accused of running from his plush London home was only part of a bigger setup with American ramifications, the sources added.

The American officials already had established that Ward did not like Americans and that he lost no opportunity to say derogatory things about them.

Favors Ties With East

Though here never has been any decisive evidence that Ward is or was a Communist, there was evidence that he was well

disposed toward the Russians and frequently said that Britain should look to the East and not to the West for peace and prosperity.

Among the revelations linking the London vice operation with America was the discovery that one call girl operating from a Chelsea apartment here was a Chinese-American named Susy, who was mixed up in the Harry Alan Towers case in New York in May, 1961.

Towers, then 40, a suave London TV producer, was charged with importing stunning blonde Maria Novotny, then 19, into the

U. S. for the purpose of prostitution and with living off her earnings as a call girl.

He Fled to Russia

Towers jumped bail and fled to Russia, where he was subsequently spotted in Moscow and Rostov. When last seen by an Englishman in Russia, Towers said he intended to go to Peking. That was the last heard from him.

Maria skipped probation and returned to London.

Federal prosecutors said at the time that Towers had brought number of girls into the U. S. since 1959 for immoral purposes.

Mr. ~~Henry~~ Swank, Special Assistant to Secretary of State Rusk, called at 11:10 a.m. relative to his earlier call today at which time he advised he would talk to Secretary Rusk on the State Department plans to check into the allegations that the American Embassy in London had been informed of the various aspects of the Keeler affair in January 1963.

Swank says that Secretary Rusk has decided to send Mr. William C. Burdett, Deputy Assistant Secretary for European Affairs, to London to check into this. Burdett was scheduled to go to London anyway and will make his inquiries early next week, looking toward furnishing the information to Secretary Rusk personally, who will be in London the middle of next week. Swank said Burdett should develop the information by next Tuesday and furnish it to Secretary Rusk next Thursday.

Swank wanted to know whether, in view of the delicacy of the Embassy angle in this matter, it was necessary to furnish the results of this inquiry to the FBI. I repeated to him that we are not investigating the matter in London and it is the prerogative of the State Department to decide what dissemination shall be made of Mr. Burdett's inquiries.

Harry Alan Towers, British TV producer, born 10/19/20 in London induced Maria Novotny, a 19 year old (born in England 5/9/41) British model and TV actress to come to NYC on 12/14/60 and work as a model and TV actress. Towers arrived on 12/10/60. Upon her arrival, Towers immediately engaged her into lucrative prostitution during which she earned about \$400 per week \$300 of which he took. She utilized four personal phone numbers to arrange her prostitution dates. One phone listed to Towers at 140 W. 55th ST., NYC, apt. 4A; one to Novotny at 300 East 46th St., apt. 18D, NYC; one to Horace R. Dibben, her husband, at same 46th ST. address and one to E. M. Adams at 54 East 83rd St., NYC apt 4C. In addition, she employed the American Answering Service at 121 W. 72nd St., apt 2A, NYC to take calls for her.

Assistant District Attorney William F. Reilly received an anonymous telephone call, advising that Maria Novotny had been using the American Answering Service to actively solicit prostitution dates and had been entertaining them at 140 East 55 th St., NYC. Mr. Reilly advised detectives at the 54th St. Police Station, NYC, of the above anonymous call. One of the

detectives contacted the answering service and left an assumed name and telephone number with an extension at a hotel in NYC. Novotny returned his call and advised that a prostitution date could be arranged for a minimum fee of \$30. The detective was instructed to go to apt 4A at 140 Wst 55th St., NYC, between 11:30 and 12 o'clock on 3/3/61. Shortly after the detective had entered the apt, Novotny had disrobed at which point he called in two other detectives who arrested Novotny and also arrested Towers who was also in the apt at that time. Towers was charged with maintaining a disorderly house and Novotny was charged with soliciting for the purposes of prostitution.

Towers was held on \$10,000 bail and incarcerated in the Manhattan House of Detention for lack of bail until his hearing on 3/7/61. Novotny was released on \$500 cash bail and had indicated a desire to cooperate with authorities.

On 3/6/61, Special Agents of the FBI attempted to interview Towers at the Manhattan House of Detention but he refused to be interviewed.

On 3/7/61, an authorized complaint was filed before U.S. Commissioner Earl Bishopp in the Southern District of New York

charging Towers with violation of the White Slave Traffic Act, Title 18, Section 2421, in that he transported Maria Novotny from England to New York for the purpose of prostitution. A Detainer was placed against Towers at the Manhattan House of Detention. On 3/15/61, Towers was released by NYC authorities on \$5000 bail and was arraigned same date before U.S. Commissioner Earl E. Bishopp, Southern District of New York, at which time bail was set at \$5000 which was posted by Towers on the same date.

On 4/12/61, Towers was indicted by the Grand Jury, Southern District of New York, on five counts of the White Slave Traffic Act, violation of title 18, Sections 2421 and 2422 and Title 8, Section 1328. The latter violation is the unlawful importing of an alien into the U.S. for an immoral purpose. Towers' case was scheduled for 4/25/61 at which time he could plead to the above charges.

On 4/25/61 Towers appeared before U.S. District Court Judge Charles M. Metzner, SDNY, and Towers pleaded not guilty

to five counts charging him with violations of Title 18, Sections 2421 and 2422 and Title 8, Section 1328. At that time AUSA Alfred J. Donati Jr., SDNY, requested bail be increased on Towers from \$5,000 to \$25,000 because it appeared that a large number of influential and wealthy persons would probably be interested in having Towers leave the country rather than face charges and incur embarrassment to these associates of Towers. Judge Metzner refused to raise bail and Towers was released after posting bail of \$5,000. Trial was scheduled for 5/16/61.

Novotny, according to INS, which was advised by the Cunard Lines, booked passage aboard the "Queen Mary" on 5/31/61 under the name of Mrs. R. Tyson, address Essex House, C/O J. Lear, 30 Bouverie Street, London, England. She had not boarded the Queen Mary in the normal procedure through the Embarkation Officer and it appeared she had gone aboard the "Queen Mary" as a visitor without clearing her ticket through the Embarkation Officer. She occupied first class cabin B-63 under name of Mrs. R. Tyson. Her identity was discovered after the ship left NYC and the British Immigration Officer was advised. She identified herself to him as Maria Novotny and since she was a British subject she was permitted to leave the ship on 6/4/61 at Southhampton where she was met by her husband Horace Dibben and her mother Estelle Capes. After her arrival in England, the "News of the World" published several stories re her activities in the U.S. with Towers, and her escape from the U.S.

We continually pursued AUSA Donati concerning possible extradition of Towers to the U.S.; however, the AUSA, SDNY, never resolved whether Towers could legally be extradited for his crime. Our Legal Attache in London reviewed the Extradition Treaty in existence between Great Britain and the U.S. and could not see how the AUSA could accomplish Towers' extradition under the enumerated crimes listed in the Treaty.

Federal process is still outstanding against the subject who is reportedly in Prague, Czechoslovakia, where he is considering taking out permanent residence. On 3/6/63 AUSA, SDNY, desires to keep this case in a suspended category and will consider prosecuting Towers should his office become aware of Towers' return to the U.S.

We are alert to the possibility of extraditing Towers should he take residence in any country that such extradition is legally possible.

Observation

Towers was out on bail and we had no indication he would flee. We do not conduct surveillances on individuals who are out on bail.

It is obvious that several well known people in the TV industry and other wealthy people in NYC were anxious for Towers to leave the U.S. to avoid public embarrassment to themselves should he openly discuss the identities of persons for whom he procured prostitutes.

Towers was broke otherwise he would not have engaged himself as a pimp and he could not get \$10,000 bail when sent to Manhattan House of Detention where he remained from 3/3/61 until 3/15/61 when bail was reduced to \$5,000 by NYC court. However, it is noted that several well-to-do figures in the TV industry stated when interviewed he was making large sums of money which was never verified, particularly the \$12,000 royalty deal (which may have been a pay-off) and his \$195,000 deal.

Maria Novotny was obviously aided by persons unknown to leave the U.S. as she didn't have the brain power nor the money to execute her departure scheme. It is further noted her/^{mother}and her husband who were in the U.S. at the same time met her when she landed in England. Her escape was very necessary because she was the chief witness and even if Towers ~~comes~~ back it is doubtful if he can be prosecuted sucessfully ~~without~~ her as a Government or State witness.

There definitely has been no dereliction on our part as we do not surveil a subject of a case of this nature while he is out on bail. In fact, we would be criticized for it if we did, most likely. Novotny on the other hand was actually an INS charge as she was an alien charged with an immoral act and would have been deported.

During the conference with Secretary McNamara, Mr. McCone, and Lt. Gen. Carroll, in McNamara's office yesterday afternoon, on the Keeler-Profumo matter, there were two items which I brought up which are not contained in my memorandum of 6/20/63.

I told Secretary McNamara that we had picked up rumors to the effect that the FBI had possessed the information on this case back in 1961 and had briefed the British on it at that time. I told McNamara that we had checked our records and with our people in London and there was no substance to these rumors; that we are running down any rumors of this type to pin them down.

I also mentioned that we have learned that the NY Journal-American is going to put out a story on a case involving one Harry Alan Towers, who was engaged in vice activities several years ago; that this man Towers had come to NY from London and had brought in a call girl by the name of Maria Novotny, as a result of which the NY Police Department arrested Towers. The FBI subsequently filed a complaint against him alleging violation of the White Slave Traffic Act, and he fled, and we understand is now living in Czechoslovakia. The girl Novotny is now in London and newspaper accounts indicate her husband, Horace Diben, was involved with vice activities in London. I stated that we do not know just what angle the Journal-American is going to play on this story, but we are attempting to check into it.



Mr. McNamara referred to a memorandum from the FBI dated June 14, 1963, advising that Air Force personnel may have had relationships with Christine Keeler. (This is our memorandum to the Attorney General and O'Donnell dated June 14, 1963.) I furnished Mr. McNamara and Mr. McCone with a copy of this letter of June 14. McNamara wanted to know why Carroll didn't have this information. Carroll told him this was being checked out; that the three Airmen were being flown back today for interview by Air Force personnel

McNamara said he felt like he was sitting on a bomb in this matter as he could not tell what would come out of it and he wanted to be sure that every effort was being made to get information from the British particularly as it affected U. S. personnel. *(u)*

I told Mr. McNamara that we are in a liaison capacity in London and are getting all information we can but we are not operational and have no jurisdiction abroad. I told him we would continue such liaison and would include McNamara and McCone in any dissemination we make.

Mr. ^{EMORY} Swank, who said he was Secretary Rusk's special assistant, called at 9:35 a.m. to advise that Secretary Rusk had asked him to check into the report that there were some contacts with the Embassy in London with regard to the Profumo-Keeler matter

Swank said that there is nothing in State Department files to substantiate that there were such meetings at the London Embassy, but this, of course, did not mean that the meetings did not take place (Legat Bates previously told us that the Embassy did not report this to Washington).

Swank said that Secretary Rusk would probably appoint a personal emissary to take this up with the Ambassador in London. Swank wanted to know whether the FBI was investigating this matter in London regarding these contacts with the Embassy.

I told Swank that our Legat is maintaining liaison with sources, to get such information as he can in a liaison capacity, but that the FBI is not investigating the contacts with the Embassy because this is a matter that should be handled by the State Department.

Swank said he just wanted to know, as he was going to see Secretary Rusk in the next few minutes and would advise him accordingly. He said he would let us know who the Secretary's emissary would be and when he would leave for London.
