On December 24, 1950, the Michigan Edition of the Daily Worker in a column entitled "Autotown Alley" by "The Old Timer" contained the following reference to our posters:

"The F.B.I. now has notices posted in all bulletin boards in plants trying to get workers to turn stoolpigeon by asking workers to turn in reports 'on subversives.' The top U.A.W. brass of course goes along."
