He had a mental age of 14½ and an IQ of 90. He was shy with strangers and had no knowledge of current events, routine holidays or other items of common knowledge. He was diagnosed as a Neuropathic, psychopathic personality, emotionally dull and indifferent with prognosis as being poor.

IV. CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES

November 14, 1957 Apalachin Meeting

The January 11, 1958 edition of the "New York Mirror" newspaper carried an article captioned, "12 ON LAM IN MAFIA PROBE", which reported the activities of the Legislative Watchdog Committee of New York. A portion of this article is quoted as follows:

"Investigators said Galante was among 60 hoodlums at November's conclave in the home of Joseph Barbara at Apalachin. He also had visited there in October 1956, when he was arrested as a traffic violator."

He stated that two other individuals were also involved in this holdup, and GALANTE stayed behind and shot it out with arresting officers, permitting the other two individuals to escape. He stated that from his experience with GALANTE at this time and the information he has learned since then, he considers GALANTE to be a vicious killer with no emotions whatsoever. He added that since GALANTE's involvement in the murder of CARLO TRESKA and the fact that he refused to talk concerning this, he began his rise in the criminal underworld to where he now occupies the position of a trusted lieutenant.

GAROFALO, like GALANTE, was very evasive but did state that the three men had come to this area on October 17 instead of the 18th as stated by GALANTE. His reason for coming to this area was to see the "great IBM factories". He was described as a white male, 65 years old, 5'7" tall, 170 pounds, wearing glasses, brown eyes, gray hair, and speaking with decided Italian accent. He stated that he owned and operated the Highgrade Packing Company at the above 58th Street address. He exhibited a card of this company which contained his name and also an address of Post Office Box 1370, Merced, California.

This is to advise relative to the adjournment of the trial of [REDACTED] and others in the U. S. District Court at Los Angeles, California, on February 28, 1961.

At the outset of this trial, U. S. District Court Judge Tolin ordered revocation of the bail bonds and all five defendants committed to the custody of the Marshal. [REDACTED] was subsequently released on \$5,000 bond. Subjects [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] were denied bonds. The four defendants who were denied bonds on February 24, 1961, appealed to the Circuit Court of Appeals at San Francisco and the hearing was set for February 28, 1961. Arguments were heard on that date on the defense appeal and the court took the matter under consideration and has as yet not rendered a decision.

\*Ninth Circuit

The right of the Judge to deny defendants on trial the right to make bond has just been upheld by Justice Harlan of the United States Supreme Court. In the narcotics case involving Carmine Galante and [REDACTED] and many others in New York City, the U. S. District Court Judge denied the defendants the right to make bail and has held them in jail during the period of the trial. Four of them, including Galante and [REDACTED] appealed and the Circuit Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit upheld the U. S. District Court Judge. An appeal was made and argument had before Justice Harlan of the Supreme Court last week and on February 27, 1961, he filed a one-man opinion upholding the Circuit Court and the U. S. District Court Judge in his right to deny defendants the right to bond while the case is pending trial.

This decision of Justice Harlan upholding the Government was brought to the attention of Government counsel arguing the case in the Ninth Circuit, who in turn brought it to the attention of the court. Advice was received that the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals would await the printed opinion of Justice Harlan in the New York case before deciding the appeal in this matter.

DETAILS

PROSECUTION & CONVICTION

On May 17, 1960, CARMINE GALANTE surrendered in Federal Court, Southern District of New York, as a result of a secret indictment made public on May 6, 1960, charging GALANTE and twenty-nine other defendants with conspiracy for violation of the Federal Narcotics Laws. Subject pled not guilty before Federal Judge MC GOHEY, Southern District of New York, on May 17, 1960, and the Judge directed the subject's \$100,000 bond, which he posted on a prior narcotics conspiracy violation, to cover this present case and he was released pending trial. The first trial, which included the subject and twenty other defendants, commenced on November 30, 1960, in the Southern District of New York. The presiding judge on January 30, 1961, during the proceedings of the trial, saw fit to revoke bail of all the defendants and remanded them to federal custody. This action was necessitated after a woman government witness had allegedly been threatened.

NY 92-911

The prosecution of these defendants, including the subject was declared a mistrial on May 15, 1961, due to the inability of the jury foreman to appear for trial due to injuries sustained in an accident. The subject was released on \$135,000 on June 2, 1961.

The subject's retrial commenced in April, 1962, and on June 25, 1962, the jury brought in a verdict of guilty for each defendant.

On July 10, 1962, Federal Judge LLOYD F. MC MAHON, United States District Court, Southern District of New York, sentenced the subject to thirty years imprisonment.

The "New York Daily News" of July 11, 1962, contained an article on page 4 entitled "Big John Ormento and Dope Mob Get Up To 40 Years - Starting Now". This article reflected the following:

Federal Judge LLOYD F. MC MAHON stated that at the time of the sentencing of the defendants in the Federal Narcotics trial in the Southern District of New York he would deny them bail pending their appeal and remand them to federal custody. He stated "there would be danger to the public, to the witnesses, to the jurors and to the court personnel, if bail were granted pending appeal". Appeals of the defendants were "merely frivolous for many possible questions of law have been deliberately created by the defendants' obvious plot to frustrate justice by terrorism".




