SYNOPSIS OF FACTS:

Information received that Japanese Chamber of Commerce officials have on several occasions spoken before the Hartford, Conn. Chapter of the "MOORISH SCIENCE TEMPLE OF AMERICA," a Negro organization in the U. S. claiming over 1,000 members who describe themselves as Moors and not Negroes. Series of six articles prepared for a Hartford newspaper about this Moorish organization obtained and forwarded to Bureau.

DETAILS:

AT HARTFORD, CONNECTICUT

The information contained in this matter was obtained from a confidential informant in Hartford, Conn. whose name is being forwarded to the Bureau under separate cover.

Informant advised that a Negro individual known as "Grand Sheikh [REDACTED]" who resides in Brooklyn, N. Y., came to Hartford, Conn. in the summer of 1936 and established local chapter No. 35 of "The Moorish Science Temple of America, Inc." which organization he believes is one that was originally founded by "The Prince of Wales" of Chicago, Ill.

The informant further advised that this organization was believed founded for the purpose of "uplifting the lot of the poor negro in the United States." He stated further that this organization claims to have over 8,000,000 members at the present time throughout the United States.

Informant stated that the reason he thought this matter would be of interest to the Federal Bureau of Investigation was the fact that on several occasions members of the Japanese Chamber of Commerce were reported to have spoken at meetings held by the Hartford Chapter and that, therefore, there was the possibility the Japanese government might be spreading propaganda at these meetings. Informant advised that he has a negro informant who attends the meetings held and who has given him information about what transpired at the various meetings. He informed that this organization has not been very active recently and the summer of 1939 was the last time that Japanese officials spoke at the Hartford meetings. He stated that in the event he receives further information about the activities of this organization he will immediately notify the writer.

Informant furnished the writer a photo of the cover of the "Holy Koran of the Moorish Science Temple of America," and also photos of three inside pages of this same book. In addition to this the informant furnished the writer rough draft proofs of six short articles he had prepared for possible publication in a Hartford newspaper. Photostatic copies were made of the above material and one set of these photostats are being forwarded to the Bureau and another set is being retained in the New York file on this matter. The originals of the above were returned to the informant.

No further investigation will be conducted on this matter by the New York Division unless the Bureau directs to the contrary. Two copies of this report are being forwarded to the Chicago Division inasmuch as the main headquarters for this organization is given as "Noble Drew Ali, founder, Moorish Science Temple of America, 930 W. Townsend St., Chicago, Ill."



6. We, as a clean and pure nation descended from the inhabitants of Africa, do not desire to amalgamate or marry with the families of the pale skin nations of Europe. Neither serve the gods of their religion, because our forefathers are the true and divine followers of the first religious creed, for the redemption and salvation of mankind on earth.

7. Therefore we are returning the Church and Christianity back to the European nations, as it was prepared by their forefathers for their earthly salvation.

8. While we, the Moorish Americans are returning to Islam, which was founded by our forefathers for our earthly and divine salvation.

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"The Friend of every temple must by Law Obey the word of the Prophet, and if any Head Leader or Head of any Temple fails to obey those laws - embezzlement is his charge and is subject to enforcement of the Law by the Grand Body."

Thus reads the second paragraph of Part II of a document presumably prepared by Noble Drew Ali, founder of the Moorish Science Temple of America, and placed in the hands of Grand Shell Boy, head of the local temple situated at 228

"and the penalty," paragraph three reads, "may be a fine or removed from office; or placed under a very heavy restriction of the Law."

As the head of an organization of several hundred Hartford Negro members who profess the practice of Mohammedanism, Roy is also advised in this folder containing the "by-laws" that he must submit a monthly report of all finances to headquarters in Chicago.

"Moreover, he is cautioned that he must refrain from "all vicious habits," from property even "in the mildest form," from "any alcohol liquors or any other wrongful wrath" which might "bring him greater to destroy peace on my other or the divine principles" and from contributing to anything that will cause the public to disgrace him.

A Grand Sheikh must live "the life of Love, Truth, Justice, Freedom and Justice," and must keep his house "clean with good, kind words."

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"If there are Children you must see to their support," the by-laws continued. "Follow this Divine principle, for if you don't restrict to this divine principle, then you are not a true Moor." Every member of the organization believes himself to be descended from Moors.

"And the heads" are not to charge for "membership," the rules say, and "there are to charge for cards, buttons or for anything issued by the prophet."

"Those who contribute to either of the proceeding are not Moors but Robbers. Membership Fee for Sisters and Brothers is not only here but all over the world."

Price of the buttons (.25¢) and of the citizenship card (.25¢) and the amount of monthly dues (.50¢) is then cited. "This I not said does not entitle you to the protection that is provided for you, and especially if you are working, or in a position to work," the by-laws read.

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"If you neglect to fulfill this small duty necessitated you, how
can you rightfully exact money or any other help when you are
sick or otherwise disabled?"

"And to be a real Moorish Leader," the by-laws state, "you
must study the Koran and the Divine Constitution that is handed
down unto you by me, the Prophet."

It is added that "the head of any couple can maintain an

Under a page headed "SUPREME WORDS OF THE PROPHET NOB
DREW ALL" members are informed "that they must end all radical Ag-
itating speeches while at work, in their homes, or on the streets.

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aptop fleshing your hands (elbow) at appropriate times. To cause continued remembrance of your oath is for your sake. We will have to obey those orders, while we are in severe circumstances. We are for love, truth, peace, freedom and when these principles are violated, Justice must then take its course," the Supreme words say.

"Any member or group of members who holds malicious feelings toward the temple or the proprie, or violate the living covenant of the Moorish movement will receive their reward from Allah for their unjust actions. It is prohibited to here any language.

Should a member lose confidence in his prophet, he should return their card, button and motto bearing their name or Pez and return to the office where I made contact, furnish your name for a holy and living covenant. In view of this command notice from Allah, that if the prophet is not right, then Islam is not right, according to the commandments.

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It is the "W^lful" and "devine" duty of every good member if he is able in finance, to aid me, in saving the nation and if he does not, he is an enemy to the cause of uplifting his own people and Justice must catch you," according to additional laws of the prophet.

Besides prompt attendance at meetings, Moorish-Americans are commanded to send their children to Sunday School, "and the teacher must confirm himself to the question (peculiarly the teacher must confirm himself to the question who inculcates the catechism). And let every member consecrate his five senses who is able to do so, because out from your sensory school comes the adheres of the Nation." In addition, members must not work for the enemies of America, that is, England or France or any other European power. b7C



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
ARTICLE IV

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Someday when sufficient funds are available Hartford members of the Moorish Science Temple of America here hope to build a "mosque," according to Grand Sheikh head of the local organization.



"We don't know when we can build a mosque because money is so short," the Grand Sheik explained. "It's really slow now. We can hardly live." To support his wife and four children, the oldest 18, he gets about \$12 weekly as a WPA worker "on the reservoir" here where he cuts and piles wood and burns accumulations that cannot be used for fuel.

Until such time then as an adequate sum can be raised, the Moorish-Americans will hold their religious services and social functions on the second and third floors of an old building at 229 Village Street.

Conducted by Grand Sheik May, the regular meetings are held Friday night, called the "Divine Night," because "Friday was the first day that man was formed in the flesh and the day he departed out of the flesh. On Sundays from 1 to 3 p.m. "Please in Mohammedanism" are held. Other than those, excepting special business sessions, no other meetings are held, though on some Saturday nights members gather at the temple for dances.

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Closed to the white man, the services are held in a hall on the third floor of the Village Street building with a seating capacity of about 100, the normal attendance. "All members never come at one time unless we have something good," the Grand Sheikh said, explaining he meant an unusually "good program."

Brightly decorated with paper streamers of brilliant, varying colors, the room is graced with a pulpit flanked on one side by the American flag and on the other by the flag of Morocco. The five points of the star in the center of the moroccan banner symbolize love, truth, peace, freedom and justice. From the walls hang two documents, one a certificate from Chicago headquarters and the second consisting of articles of association issued by the State of Connecticut to the Temple on May 10, 1937. Formed as an organization without capital stock, the Temple paid a charter fee of \$15 and declared its' purpose was to uplift "fallen humanity" and "to teach our people to obey the laws of the government, also their nationality and religion." At the State Capitol records show the corporation to be situated at 36 Bellevue Street, Albany, N.Y. Named as the agent on whom process may be served is Grand Sheikh

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city. The donning of fozzes, black ones by the ushers, and of turbans, mostly scarlet, by the women, is necessary at the services. The color of the assemblage is further heightened by the wearing by both sexes of extremely bright costumes of red, blue, green, yellow, pink, in fact, most any hue desired. The men are armed in flashing, baggy trousers, waists and capes, and the women in equally arresting gowns. According to Countryman-Bey most of the costumes are home-made.

Lasting from two and a half to three hours, the regular services open with a prayer to Allah. Rising and facing the East, the members bow their heads, hold up seven fingers, the five of the right hand and two of the left, and repeat: "Allah, the Father of my Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom and Justice. Allah is my protector, my guide and my salvation and by night and by day through his Holiness the prophet, Noble Drew Ali. Amen." Presumably the raised fingers symbolize the seven eyes of Allah referred to in the orthochilism. The prayer is repeated at the close of the meeting.

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From after the opening to just before the end of the session the ritual is pretty free and quite impromptu. Parts of "The Holy Koran" are read. "Bey," said "mcst any chapter" was chosen for a meeting. Then, there is the singing of religious songs taken from Negro Christian churches and altered to fit the new faith. "Ole-Time Religion" becomes "Islam Is That Ole-Time Religion" and "Steal Away To Jesus" becomes "Steal Away to Allah."

Considerable time is also reserved for the delivery of extemporaneous and unsolicited remarks on most any subject chosen by individual members of the congregation. "Bey explained that between songs "different ones testify." "They tell how they enjoy the religion and the nationality and other things," he said. Students of the organization have declared that their free expression is one of the great attractions to many members. They reason that the Moorish-Americans grew tired of the Christian ministers doing all the sermonizing, so they joined a religion that allows them to talk, too.

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At some of the auctions a special collection is taken up
for the sick and the needy and accordingly distributed. Dues are
also collected at one service which was taken in in Aug and \$1.05
for the sick. The finances of the Parable are handled by a special
committee consisting of Mrs. and Mrs. Jack, fund there in rent of \$2.
per month to be used for the sick.

"Persons of another faith are barred from the services. 'I would be beyond my jurisdiction to allow one of another faith to attend one of our services,' she said. 'We don't care to convert anyone.'

b7c, designated head of the eastern division of the Moorish Science Temple, has told the local congregation of the b7c its new relation to the true Mohammedanism and is telling them that b7c obey.

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admitting that perhaps all of the "principles" of Islam are not yet employed" by the Huruford people, New York, contends that what is practiced is at least a part of the genuine Islam ritual, and hope expresses the hope that eventually the congregation may master all of it.

Turner-el did not, he stated, lend them to believe that with "Holy Koran" of the cult is the true Koran. They believe that a part of it is. As to the sources of the rest of the book, he does not pretend to know them, but he believes everything in the "Koran" as far as "I've studied it." He knows that Marcus Garvey, founder of the Universal Negro Improvement Association, who is mentioned in the "Koran" as the forerunner of the prophet, was placed in prison for using the mails to defraud, but the fact does not distract him, nor does it appear incompatible in his mind with the religion.

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167 said he does not believe there is any

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as long as he and the congregation follow the laws as assertedly laid down by Noble Drew Ali, the founder of the organization, Ley and other members will be in good standing.

Let them depart, however, from the rules as printed in literature of the national movement, and expulsion is inevitable. These are ~~not~~ a study in themselves.

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ARTICLE III.

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Jesus was first reincarnated into the person
of the Prophet Mohammed, and Satan gave himself the title of God.
This, at any rate, is what the catechism of
the Moorish Science Temple of America teaches, among many fascinating
things, to a reported several hundred Hartford Negro adults
and children who have left Christian Churches here to follow what
they believe is their true religion, an apocryphal Islam.

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In this document, known as "Koran Questions For Moorish Americans" are found in question-answer style a very strange assortment of assertions all aimed to satisfy the devout colored reader that he is not a Negro and that his real religion is Islam.

With an almost admirable disregard for what Christians believe to be fact, the irreconcilables have been harmonized enough to allow the Negro to carry away with him to his new faith those elements of Christianity which still strongly appeal. He is, logically speaking, able to have his cake and eat it, too. In "The Holy Koran," the sacred book of the Moorish-Americans, virtually all of the same ideas are present, but the ingenuity and effectiveness of presentation found in the catechism is absent.

Presumably prepared by Noble Drew Ali, the supposed late founder of the Moorish Science Temple, whose name appears on the cover of the document and who is represented in a symbolic drawing beneath the title as rescuing fallen humanity, the questions cover a wide range of subjects.

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The faithful learn of their god, prophet and nationality at the beginning as follows:

"Who made you? ALLAH.

"Who is ALLAH? ALLAH is the Father of the Universe.

"Can we see him? No.

"Where is the nearest place we can meet him? In the heart.

"Who is Drew Noble Ali? He is ALLAH's Prophet.

"What is the duty of a prophet? To aye nations from the wrath of ALLAH.

"What is your nationality? Moorish-American.

"Why are we Moorish-Americans? Because we are descendants of Moroccans and born in America.

"How did the Prophet begin to uplift the Moorish-American? By teaching them to be themselves."

There ensues the definition of the sect and some interesting statements regarding Jesus:

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. . .

"What is our religion? Islamism.
"Is that a new, or is that the old time religion? Old time religion.

"What kind of a flag is the Moorish. It is a red flag with a five pointed green star in the center.

"What do the five points represent? Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom and Justice.

"How old is our flag? It is over 10,000 years old.

"Which is our Holy Day? Friday.
Why? Because Friday is the day on which man was formed, the flesh, and it was on Friday when He departed out of flesh.
Who was Jesus? He was a Prophet of Allah.
Will you give in brief the line (geneology) through which Jesus came? Some of the great fathers through which Jesus came are: Abraham, Boaz by Ruth, Jesse, King David, Solomon, Hozeh Mah and Joseph by Mary.

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"Why did ATTAK send Jesus to this earth? To save the Israelites from the iron-hand oppression of the pale-skin nations of Europe, who were governing a portion of Palestine at that time."

"Where do we get the name Jesus? From the East.
What does Jesus mean? Jesus means Justice."

"Did the Angel give to the Child that was called Jesus a Holy name? Yes, but it cannot be used by those who are slaves to sin."

Probably the term 'Christ' is meant. For according to Christ man Grand Shell Bey complained that it signifies "something that has been crushed. He complained that it signifies 'that' which we don't use it." crushed out."

On the subjects of truth and freedom and Eden and the first "physical man," the Moorish-American learns:

"What did Jesus say that would make you free? TRUTH."

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"What is TRUTH? TRUTH is right.

"What is AUGHT? AUGHT is always.
"Can TRUTH change? TRUTH cannot change, or pass away.

"What other name do we give to TRUTH? HOLY BREATH.

"What have you to say about the HOLY BREATH? ALL we
say is it is Great. It is good. It was, it is, and evermore to be
say.

AMEN.

"At what place on earth was the physical part of MAN formed?
In the Garden of Eden.

"Where is the Garden of Eden? In the Land of Canaan, in
the City of Mecca.

"What is the modern name for the garden of Edon? MECCA.

"What is the name of the eight physical man? His name

cannot be used, only by Executive Order of the A.C. of the R.T.

"What are the words of the A.C. of the R.T. of A.C. Adop-
tive Chamber of the Moorish Science Temple of America (Zion Heaven.)

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One learns then that the Holy City of Mecca is purged by olive-skin angels with the modern name of "Asiaties" whose duty is to ward off unbelievers. "Are the Moorish Americans any relatives to those Angels?" Yes, we all have this same father and mother.

The five descendants of Adam and Eve are known as "Lower-self, Satan, Devil, Demon and Pagan," according to the Gnosticism, the Devil is sometimes known as the "Lower-self." To balance this there is a higher self identified as "the Father of Virtues and the harmonies of life" that "breeds Justice, Virtue, Tolerance and other Contrariwise from the Lower-self breeding Ignorance, Indolence, Thievery, Murder, Theft and everything that hurtles."

"What did the Higher-self say to the Lower-self at one time when He met Him? Where are you going, Satan?"
"What was the answer the Lower-self gave to the Higher-self?

"I am going to and fro the earth seeking whom I may devour.
"Has He finished His task of devouring?" Yes.
"When was His task declared cut?" When He nailed Jesus on

the cross.

"What are the last words Jesus uttered? It is finished.

"Did Jesus say, that He would return to conquer Him? Yes.
What is the name of the person into whom Jesus was first

After giving Mohamed credit for the deception, the cat
chess plunges into definitions and winds up with reference to the
cryptic circle that graces the cover of "The Holy Koran." In its
center is a bright red "7".

"Name some of the marks that were put upon the bodies of
thwest, by the European nations in 1774? Negro, Black, Colored
and Ethiopia.

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Negro, it is asserted, is "a name given to a river in West Africa by Moors, because it contains black water, and black, according to science, means death."

What does the word colored mean? Colored means anything that has been painted, stained, varnished or dyed. And, as long as in "The Holy Quran," Ethiopia "means something divided,"

"Can a man be a Negro, Black, Colored or Ethiopian? No. Why? Because man is made in the Image and after the likeness of God, Allah."

"What title does Satan give Himself? God. Will you define the word White? White means purity, Purity means God, and God means the Ruler of the Land.

"To whom do we refer at all times, as being the GREAT ALLAH."

The Devil, the catechism asserts, was made by Elohim, identified as the "Seven Creative Spirits that created everything...

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"What is Elohim sometimes called? The SEVEN EYES OF ALLAH.
"How many days are in the Circle? Seven days.
"How many days are in a creation? Seven days.
"How many days are in a year? Seven days.
And finally: "According to science, how many days are in a

year? Seven days."

Thus equipped with their "Koran" and catechism, the followers of the Moorish Science Temple of America assemble at their headquarters on Village Street to practice the faith.

If a president of the United States were convicted of a felony, sent to a Federal penitentiary, later deported and then came to be mentioned in the Bible as a prophet who visited our earth to warn the nations that Christ was coming to stamp out all evil, it would be only a slightly exaggerated parallel of a situation existing in the Hartford branch of the Moorish Science temple.

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Comparable to the Garrison Bible, "The Holy Koran" of the Moorish-Americans here Aaron Marcus Harvey, the deported Jamaican Negro founder of The Universal Negro Improvement Association as a "divinely prepared" forerunner of Noble Drew Ali, the prime mover of so-called colored Moslem temples of the national orientation of one race.

Perhaps Mr. Harvey will be better remembered if one refers to his "black-to-african" movement and his 17½ years imprisonment of jealous followers (stigmatized) in Delaware, which had taken place in 1920.

Called in New York, "Sir President of Africa," after his announced intention of taking possession of the dark Continent, starting with Liberia, and establishing independent Negro governments there, the Jenkins was subsequently convicted by a United States District Court of using the mails to defraud, fined \$500 and sentenced to five years in the Federal penitentiary at Atlanta. On completion of his sentence in 1927, he was deported, and on one occasion thereafter he was requested to leave Canada, where he had gone from his West Indies home.

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"John the Baptist was the forerunner of Jesus in those days to warn and stir up the nations and prepare them to receive the divine creed which was to be taught by Jesus," The Holy Koran used by Hartford members of the faith reads in part.

"In these modern days there came a forerunner, who was certainly prepared by the great God-Allah and his name is Marcus Garvey," the chapter continues, "who did teach and warn the nations of the earth to prepare to meet the coming prophet; who was to bring the true and divine flood of Islam, and his name is Nuhu Drew Ali; who was prepared and sent to this earth by Allah, to teach the old time religion and the everlasting gospel to the son of man."

Except for one important fact, the irreveribility here might not be so striking, aside, of course, from the mention of Jesus, Allah and Islam together. For it may be assumed that at the time The Holy Koran was being put together, Mr. Garvey was in his hey-day.

city himself something of a messiah to hundreds of thousands, if not millions, of Negroes, he would appeal as a prophet. At the moment when his name was set down as a forerunner, he might well have been editing The Negro World and perhaps simultaneously floating The Negro Factories Corporation, which was capitalized at \$1 million dollars, and selling shares like hotcakes, at \$5 each, in his \$10,000,000 steamship line.

But Mr. Garvey was proud of his Negro blood. In an autobiographical article appearing in "Current History" in 1923 in defense of his activities, he wrote: "My parents were black negroes." Not only the Holy Koran, but also the catechism used by the Moorish-Americans, stoutly deny the existence of the Negro race.

"According to all true and divine records of the human race there is no negro, black, or colored race attached to the human family," the "Koran" says, "because all of the inhabitants of Africa were and are of the human race, descendants of the ancient Canaanite nation from the holy land of Canaan."

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To the casual reader "The Holy Koran" is not only of interest because of its mention of Marcus Survey and the fact that at least 11 chapters are taken almost verbatim from "The Aquarian Gospel of Jesus the Christ," a book copyrighted in 1903, but also because of other chapters which give a decidedly fresh and copious if chimerical, twist to ethnology, geology and geography.

Moslems, all, according to the "Koran," are the people of Egypt, Japan, China and India, but the inhabitants of Mexico, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Columbia, Nicaragua and San Salvador as well.

"The Egyptians, who were the Hammites, and of a direct descendant of Mizraim, the arabs, the seed of Hager, Japanese and Chinese," Chapter XVI reads in part. "The Hindoos of India, the descendants of the ancient Canaanites, Hittites and Moabites found land of Canaan. The Asiatic nations and countries in North and Central America; the Moorish Americans and Mexicans of North America, Brazilians, Argentines and millions of South Americans, Columbians, Micromans and the natives of San Salvador in Central America, etc. all of whom are Moslems."



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In the succeeding chapter the reader comes upon the heart of the religion. He learns of the origin of the words "Ethiopia" and negro and of the great earthquake that fashomed the Atlantic ocean and cut in two the huge empire of Morocco which extended at one time to embrace the Americas. There is every reason to believe that this section is read more frequently in the Temple on Village Street in Hartford than any other.

"The Inhabitants of Africa," it begins, "are the descendants of the ancient Canaanites from the land of Canaan. Old man Cush and his family were the first inhabitants of Africa who came from the land of Canaan. His father Ham and his family were second. Then came the word Ethiopia which means 'the demarcation line of the dominion of Amoxem, the first true and divine son of Africa.'

Later there was an influx of other peoples, the book says, and "their dominion and influence extended from North-East and South-West Africa, across the great Atlantis even unto the present North, South and Central America and also Mexico and the Atlantic Islands."

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"Before the great earthquake, which caused the great Atlantic Ocean," the "Koran" continues. "The River Nile was dredged a mile by the ancient Pharaohs of Egypt, in order to trade with the surrounding kingdoms. Also the River Nile was dredged by the Pharaoh of Egypt in those ancient days for trade, and it extends eastward from the River Nile, westward across the Great Atlantic."

"These holy and divine laws are from the Prophet, Noble Drew Ali, the founder of the uniting of the Moorish Science Temple of America," the "Koran" reads a few sentences later. "These laws are to be strictly preserved by the members of all the temples, the Moorish Science Temple of America. That they will learn at open their meetings and guide them according to the principles of Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom and Justice."

Skipping a few more sentences, the reader encounters: "The Prophet, Noble Drew Ali, was sent by the Great God, Allah, to warn all Asiatics of America to repent from their sinful ways; before that great and lawful day which is sure to come."

"The Time has come when every nation must worship under its own vine and fig tree, and every tongue must confess his own city.
"Through sin and disobedience every nation has suffered slavery; due to the fact that they honored not the creed, and principles of their forefathers. That is why the nationality of the slaves was taken away from them in 1774 and the word negro, black and colored, was given to the Asiatics of America who were of Moorish descent, because they honored not the principles of their mother and father, and strayed after the gods of Europe of whom they knew nothing."

After asserting in the final chapter that the Moorish Science Temple of America is a "lawfully chartered incorporated organization, the world over," this the world day b7C

"We, as a clean and pure nation descended from the ~~black~~ in
habitants of Africa, do not desire to amalgamate or marry into the
families of the pale skin nations of Europe.

"Neither serve ~~the~~ the gods of their religion, because our
forefathers are the true and divine founders of the first religion.
Therefore we are returning the Church and Christianity back
to the European Nations, as it was prepared by their forefathers
for their earthly salvation.

"While we, the Moorish Americans are returning to Islam,
which was founded by our forefathers for our earthly and divine
salvation."

The text concludes: "Come all ye Asiatic of America and other
the truth about your nationality and birthrights, because you are
not negroes. Learn of your forefathers ancient and divine creed.
That you will learn to love instead of hate.

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"We are trying to uplift fallen humanity. Come and link yourselves with the families of nations. We honor all the true and divine prophets."

Apart from the "Aquarian gospel" chapters, which mostly pertain to the activities of Jesus, much of the balance of this book is devoted to holy and divine instructions directed to young men, man and wife, children, etc.

Typical verses are the following on the duty of a husband toward his wife:

"Reprove her faults with gentleness, exact not her obedience with rigour. Consider the tenderness of her sex, the delicacy of her frame; and be not severe to her weakness, but remember her own imperfections."
