Reurairtel 3/11/75. To preclude less than best quality processing of minox film of sensitive nature (similar to that submitted by requisition of 3/4/75,) furnish future submissions by cover letter to insure manual processing is afforded.

NOTE: Minox film [redacted] was processed by machine in Photo Unit and damaged; quality of prints were decidedly less than of prior commercial capability handled manually. One shot was utilized in publication but was not of best quality. To preclude machine processing of minox film from this source in future and to insure adequate quality control to obtain best prints possible, it was agreed with WFO Agents that submissions would be made by cover letter rather than requisition. Photo Unit Supervisor has been instructed to be alert for such material and to adhere stringently to quality control reviews and inspection of all phases of processing and printing of such sensitive material.

The National Youth Alliance (NYA) is an organization originally formed from a nucleus of Youth For (George C.) Wallace supporters following the 1968 presidential election for the purpose of countering radical leftist and anarchist influences on the campuses of American colleges and universities. NYA currently is controlled by individuals who militantly promote white racialism and anti-Zionism and who suggest violent revolution ultimately as the means for implementing their racial and political ideas in America.

The February, 1974 (Number 25), issue of "Attack", the tabloid newspaper published by NYA, announced the formation of a new organization called the National Alliance (NA). The new organization was described in "Attack" as a "superstructure for an anticipated array of specialized, coordinate groups," of which NYA will continue as the youth group for individuals thirty years of age and under. Persons over thirty years of age wishing to join the "movement" must become members of the new organization. According to the "Attack", " \* \* \* the National Alliance will remain generalized in its appeal and its membership and will guide and direct all the special interest groups \* \* \* ."

PREFACE

This investigation is based on information which indicates that the National Youth Alliance (NYA) is engaged in activities which could involve a violation of Title 18, United States Code, 2383 (Rebellion or Insurrection); 2384 (Seditious Conspiracy); 2385 (Advocating the Overthrow of the Government); 231-233 (Civil Disorders); 2101-2102 (Anti-riot Laws); 241 (Conspiracy Against Rights of Citizens); and 245 (Federally Protected Activities).

The NYA was originally formed from a nucleus of Youth for (GEORGE C.) WALLACE supporters following the 1968 Presidential election for the stated purpose of countering radical leftist and anarchist influences on the campuses of American colleges and universities. Its efforts to establish in this country a German-type national socialism of the Hitler era emphasize white racist and anti-Semitic policies. The NYA tabloid newspaper, "Attack!" in its Summer, 1971, (Number 6) issue, advocated revolutionary action to destroy the existing system, since "It is no longer possible to cure the System...by Constitutional methods." A series of articles entitled "Revolutionary Notes" published in "Attack!" beginning in the Summer, 1971, (Number 6) issue, and concluding in the October, 1972, (Number 15) issue, provided readers with instructions and diagrams for the construction of simple incendiary and explosive devices and techniques of guerrilla warfare "for use in counter-revolutionary situations." The Fall, 1971, (Number 7) issue of "Attack!" carried an editorial entitled "What We Must Do Now," which discusses "revolutionary action" and states in part: "We must think...in terms of assassinating federal judges, of burning the stores of businessmen who act as if they are more interested in what's good for business than what's good for White America, of dynamiting the TV transmitters and newspaper presses of the alien news manipulators, of harshly punishing Whites--male or female--who fraternize sexually with non-Whites, of putting the fear of terrible retribution into every treacherous politician and System-serving editor, advertiser, bureaucrat, or other public person."

The February, 1974 (Number 25), issue of "Attack!" the tabloid newspaper published by NYA, announced the formation of a new organization called the National Alliance (NA). The new organization was described in "Attack!" as a "superstructure for an anticipated array of specialized, coordinate groups," of which NYA will continue as the youth group for individuals thirty years of age and under. Persons over thirty years of age wishing to join the "movement" must become members of the new organization. According to "Attack!," "the National Alliance will remain generalized in its appeal and its membership and will guide and direct all the special interest groups".

On January 1, 1967, the official name of this organization was changed to National Socialist White People's Party. The NSWPP supports and follows the line of hatred against blacks, Jews, and communists through various propaganda media, demonstrations, and other publicity-seeking devices for the purpose of seeking a legitimate dominant political party within the United States and in foreign countries. Headquartered in Arlington, Virginia, the NSWPP is currently led by MATTHIAS KOEHL, JR.

NATIONAL STATES RIGHTS PARTY

The National States Rights Party (NSRP), formerly known as the United White Party, was organized in 1957 in Knoxville, Tennessee. The NSRP's official party line promotes hatred against Jews, Negroes, Communists and certain law enforcement agencies. NSRP National Chairman J. B. STONER has publicly advocated killing or deporting Jews; deportation of Negroes; "doing away with FBI pimps"; and repeal of all civil rights laws. The NSRP carries out its line of hatred through the use of propaganda media and provocative demonstrations.



The National Youth Alliance (NYA) is an organization originally formed from a nucleus of Youth For (George C.) Wallace supporters following the 1968 presidential election for the purpose of countering radical leftist and anarchist influences on the campuses of American colleges and universities. NYA currently is controlled by individuals who militantly promote white racialism and anti-Zionism and who suggest violent revolution ultimately as the means for implementing their racial and political ideas in America. 4

The February, 1974 (Number 25), issue of "Attack!", the tabloid newspaper published by NYA, announced the formation of a new organization called the National Alliance (NA). The new organization was described in "Attack!" as a "superstructure for an anticipated array of specialized, coordinate groups", of which NYA will continue as the youth group for individuals 30 years of age and under. Persons over 30 years of age wishing to join the "movement" must become members of the new organization. According to "Attack!", " \* \* \* the National Alliance will remain generalized in its appeal and its membership and will guide and direct all the special interest groups\* \* \*." 4

Some klan members and leaders have been involved in atrocities including beatings, bombings, and murders, and have engaged in activities seeking to deny others their constitutional rights.






