Restrictions on Use

WFO FILES INDICATE THAT;

THE NATIONAL YOUTH ALLIANCE (NYA) IS AN ORGANIZATION ORIGINALLY FORMED FROM A NUCLEUS OF YOUTH FOR WALLACE SUPPORTERS FOLLOWING THE 1968 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF COUNTERING RADICAL LEFTIST AND ANARCHIST INFLUENCES ON THE COLLEGE CAMPUSES OF AMERICA.

ON 9/21/84, U.S. SECRET SERVICE (NOT TO BE IDENTIFIED TO FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS) ADVISED THE NATIONAL YOUTH ALLIANCE (NYA) REORGANIZED IN APPROXIMATELY FEBRUARY, 1974 AND FORMED THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE (NA). THE NA WAS DESCRIBED AS A "SUPERSTRUCTURE FOR AN ANTICIPATED ARRAY OF SPECIALIZED COORDINATE GROUPS". THE NYA CONTINUED AS THE YOUTH GROUP FOR PERSONS UNDER 30 YEARS OF AGE, AND THE NA FOR PERSONS OVER 30 YEARS OF AGE. THE NYA IS A COALITION OF CONSERVATIVE YOUTH GROUPS WHOSE PURPOSE WAS TO CONTROL CERTAIN CAMPUS ORIENTED GROUPS, WHICH WERE CAUSING CHAOTIC CONDITIONS ON U.S. COLLEGE CAMPUSES. THE NYA PROMOTES WHITE RACISM AND ANTI-ZIONISM, SUGGESTING VIOLENT REVOLUTION AS THE ULTIMATE MEANS FOR IMPLEMENTING THEIR IDEAS IN THE U.S. THE NYA IS OPPOSED TO THE USE OF DANGEROUS DRUGS, ANARCHISM, MARXISM, OTHER RADICAL GROUPS, FOREIGN WARS, AND BLACK ORGANIZATIONS. ~~THE ORGANIZATIONAL~~

PUBLICATION WAS KNOWN AS "ATTACK". IN 1977, THE NYA MAILING LIST WAS BELIEVED TO CONTAIN ABOUT 2,000 TO 3,000 NAMES WITH LESS THAN 100 PAID MEMBERS. THERE WERE APPROXIMATELY 12 INDIVIDUALS CONSIDERED TO BE ACTIVISTS KNOWN TO OPERATE IN CHICAGO, DETROIT, LOS ANGELES, RICHMOND (VIRGINIA), SPRINGFIELD (MASS.) AND WILMINGTON (NORTH CAROLINA). THEIR ATTEMPTS TO ESTABLISH LOCAL CHAPTERS HAVE NOT BEEN TOO SUCCESSFUL. IN 1972, THE NYA PUBLISHED A SERIES OF ARTICLES ENTITLED "REVOLUTIONARY NOTES", INSTRUCTING READERS IN THE CONSTRUCTION AND DEPLOYMENT OF SIMPLE EXPLOSIVE, INCENDIARY DEVICES AND TECHNIQUES OF URBAN GUERRILLA WARFARE. ARTICLES IN "ATTACK" HAVE ADVOCATED POLITICAL ASSASSINATION, AND DESTRUCTION OF THE SYSTEM BY TOTAL REVOLUTION. "AZTACK" IS ALIGNED WITH THE NATIONAL SOCIALIST WHITE PEOPLE'S PARTY. THE ORGANIZATION HAS IN THE PAST, ADOCATED VIOLENCES IF OTHER MEANS FAILED TO CONTROL RADICAL CAMPUS GROUPS. IN RECENT TIME, THE NA DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE ACTIVE IN ITS SPHERE OF INTERESTS, AND HAS NOT BEEN SUCCESSFUW IN ATTEMPTS TO INCREASE MEMBERSHIP.

NATIONAL ALLIANCE

The NATIONAL YOUTH ALLIANCE (NYA) is an organization originally formed from a nucleus of youth for GEORGE WALLACE supporters following the 1968, Presidential Election for the purpose of countering radical leftist and anarchist influences on the college campuses of America.

On September 21, 1984, an agency for the United States Government advised that the NATIONAL YOUTH ALLIANCE (NYA) reorganized in approximately February, 1974, and formed the NATIONAL ALLIANCE (NA). The NA was described as a "superstructure for an anticipated array of specialized coordinate groups". 




