NOTE:

THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE IS A GROUP HEADED BY WILLIAM LUTHER PIERCE WHO AUTHORED THE BOOK ENTITLED, "THE TURNER DIARIES," UTILIZING THE PSEUDONYM OF ANDREW MACDONALD. THIS BOOK, WHICH SETS FORTH AN OPERATIONAL PLAN FOR INSTITUTING A RACIAL REVOLUTION IN THE UNITED STATES BY AN EXTREME RIGHT-WING GROUP KNOWN AS THE "ORDER," WAS USED AS A BLUEPRINT BY ROBERT J. MATHEWS, A FORMER MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE, WHEN HE SET-UP HIS GROUP KNOWN AS THE "ORDER" OR "BRUDERS SCHWEIGEN."

MATHEWS AND THE "ORDER" RECRUITED MEMBERS OF LIKE-MINDED RIGHT-WING EXTREMISTS FROM SUCH GROUPS AS THE KU KLUX KLAN, [REDACTED] AND THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE. MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE WHO JOINED THE "ORDER" WERE [REDACTED] [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] THESE INDIVIDUALS MET MATHEWS AT MEETINGS OF THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE, AND THEY ALL TRAVELED TO THE STATE OF WASHINGTON FROM PENNSYLVANIA TO JOIN MATHEWS IN HIS CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES. ALL OF THESE INDIVIDUALS WERE INDICTED ON RACKETEERING CHARGES IN SEATTLE, WASHINGTON.

ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE, [REDACTED] DECLINED MATHEWS' OFFER TO JOIN THE "ORDER," BUT WAS ARRESTED FOR HIS INVOLVEMENT IN A COUNTERFEITING SCHEME THAT WAS DEVISED BY "ORDER" MEMBERS.





FOR THE INFORMATION OF PITTSBURGH, INVESTIGATION AT ALEXANDRIA ON SEPTEMBER 9, 1985, DETERMINED THAT THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE (NA) HAD VACATED THEIR FORMER LOCATION, 542 SOUTH 23RD STREET, ARLINGTON, VIRGINIA, ON SEPTEMBER 3, 1985. TO DATE, THE NEW ADDRESS FOR THE NA IS UNKNOWN, ALTHOUGH INFORMATION PROVIDED BY ALEXANDRIA HAS INDICATED THAT IT HAS MOVED SOMEWHERE "OUT IN THE COUNTRY." IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THE NA MAINTAINS A POST OFFICE BOX (POST OFFICE BOX 2264) IN ARLINGTON, VIRGINIA.

FOR FURTHER INFORMATION, WILLIAM LUTHER PIERCE, USING THE NAME ANDREW MACDONALD, AUTHORED "THE TURNER DIARIES," WHICH IS ONE OF THE HANDBOOKS UTILIZED BY THE [REDACTED] PIERCE IS RECOGNIZED AS THE LEADER OF THE NA IN ARLINGTON, VIRGINIA, AND RESIDES AT [REDACTED] ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA. A SPOT CHECK OF THIS RESIDENCE ON SEPTEMBER 11, 1985, BY ALEXANDRIA HAS INDICATED THAT THE RESIDENCE IS FOR SALE. TO DATE, THE RESIDENCE HAS NOT BEEN SOLD AND REALTORS ARE UNAWARE OF PIERCE'S NEW ADDRESS. ALEXANDRIA BELIEVES THAT THE NEW PIERCE RESIDENCE AND THE NEW LOCATION FOR THE NA ARE AT ONE AND THE SAME BUILDING. THEREFORE, ALEXANDRIA HAS REQUESTED THAT RICHMOND CONTACT UTILITY COMPANIES WITHIN ITS DIVISION IN AN EFFORT TO DETERMINE THE NEW

INVESTIGATION IN RICHMOND HAS DETERMINED THAT POST OFFICE BOX 2264 IN ARLINGTON, VIRGINIA, IS LOCATED AT THE LEANS STATION BRANCH, INSTEAD OF THE CRYSTAL CITY BRANCH, AS REPORTED IN REFERENCED COMMUNICATION. UNITED STATES POSTAL AUTHORITIES IN NORTHERN VIRGINIA ARE ATTEMPTING TO UPDATE INFORMATION ON POST OFFICE BOX 2264 AND HAVE REPORTED THAT THE BOX HAS NOT BEEN CLEARED FOR OVER SEVEN TO TEN DAYS AND IS OVERFLOWING WITH MAIL. The NATIONAL YOUTH ALLIANCE (NYA) is an organization originally formed from the NUCLEUS OF YOUTH FOR GEORGE WALLACE supporters following the 1968 Presidential Election for the purpose of countering radical leftist and anarchist influences on the college campuses of America.

On September 21, 1984, an agency for the U.S. government advised that the NYA reorganized in approximately February, 1974, and formed the NATIONAL ALLIANCE (NA). The NA was described as a "super structure for an anticipated array of specialized coordinate groups." The NYA continued as the youth group for persons under 30 years of age, and the NA for persons over 30 years of age. The NYA is a coalition of conservative youth groups whose purpose is to control certain campus-oriented groups, which were causing chaotic conditions on U.S. college campuses. The NYA promotes white racism and anti-Zionism, suggesting a violent revolution as the ultimate means for implementing their ideas in the U.S. The NYA is opposed to the use of dangerous drugs, anarchism, Marxism, other radical groups, foreign woes, and black organizations. # Remember the Liberty?

Many Americans today remember the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, although that attack took place nearly four decades ago. Likewise, most Americans remember the Alamo, even though that battle took place in 1836.

But how many Americans remember the attack made on the *U.S.S. Liberty*? This is an especially interesting question, because unlike the attacks on Pearl Harbor and the Alamo, the attack on the *Liberty* took place only a few short years ago. And also—unlike Pearl Harbor and the Alamo—this attack was not made by a country at war with the United States, but one that is supposedly our ally!

## Remember the Liberty!

On June 8, 1967, the *U.S.S. Liberty*, an unarmed, clearly marked communications vessel stationed in the Mediterranean Sea, was savagely attacked without warning in an unprovoked assault by Israeli jet fighters and torpedo boats. Thirty-four U.S. servicemen died in the attack, and another 171 were wounded.

The *Liberty's* mission was to monitor the fighting going on between Israel and its Arab neighbors, which were then at war. Specifically, the *Liberty's* task was to report any evidence picked up by its sophisticated electronic gear as to whether or not Israel was planning to use its nuclear arsenal against the Arabs. The Israelis were not about to have the United States interfere with their use of atomic weapons, no matter what the consequences might be—and so they ordered that the *Liberty* be put out of commission.

Despite the murder of 34 American fighting men, the System which governs this country has continued to give roughly \$2 billion a year in military aid to the very ones who butchered our men in an unprovoked act of blatant, premeditated aggression.

We demand that the Israeli murderers be brought to justice, and that those members of the U.S. government who have aided and abetted this outrage by their silence and complicity be punished also.
