MINUTEMEN

The Minutemen, whose headquarters are in Norborne, Missouri, was organized in June, 1960, by Robert Boliver De Pugh who has been publicly identified as the National Coordinator of the organization since its inception. On September 8, 1969, he announced the appointment of his 23-year-old son, Ralph C. De Pugh, to serve in this position while he completes a one year sentence in the U. S. Penitentiary for violation of the Federal Firearms Act.

Past statements by Robert De Pugh and literature distributed by the organization indicate the purpose of the Minutemen to be the resistance to and exposure of, the spread of Communist influence within the United States; for the formation of a guerrilla or underground organization to combat the troops of any foreign powers which might eventually occupy this country; and resist passage of laws which would regulate private ownership of firearms.

A source, who in July, 1969, had access to some Minutemen records, estimated that approximately 2500 individuals have in the past expressed an interest in the Minutemen and have been considered as members by De Pugh; however, source believes there are probably no more than 300 actual active members of the organization. A second source in October, 1969, advised that the Minutemen tend to grossly exaggerate the number of their members. The source estimated the actual membership to be no more than possibly 350 members.

In April, 1966, De Pugh, in his book, "Blueprint For Victory", wrote the Minutemen organization was then dividing into two bodies; the Minutemen and the Patriotic Party. One group, the Minutemen, would be the resistance movement and the other, the Patriotic Party, whose proper function would be to serve as the political arm of a complete patriotic resistance movement.

Members of the Minutemen organization, including Robert De Pugh and his chief assistant, Walter P. Peyson, have been

NATIONAL SOCIALIST WHITE PEOPLE'S PARTY,

On May 26, 1969, a source advised that the American Nazi Party - World Union of Free Enterprise National Socialists (ANP-WUFENS) was organized by George Lincoln Rockwell at Arlington, Virginia, on February 26, 1956. It was based upon the concept of an international "National Socialist" movement, as espoused by the German Nazi Party, which was headed by Adolf Hitler. The ANP-WUFENS supports and follows the line of hatred against Negroes, Jews and communists, through speeches, published literature, demonstrations and publicity-seeking devices for the purpose of seeking a legitimate dominant political party within the United States and in foreign countries.

"The Richmond News Leader" issue dated April 4, 1963, published daily at Richmond, Virginia, stated that this organization is chartered in the State of Virginia as "The George Lincoln Rockwell Party" and that the Virginia Assembly prohibits the use of "Nazi" or "National Socialism" in a Virginia-chartered organization. As of January 1, 1967, the official name of this organization was changed to "National Socialist White People's Party," according to Commander Rockwell.

On August 25, 1967, George Lincoln Rockwell was assassinated in Arlington, Virginia, near the ANP Headquarters Building. The August 28, 1967, issue of the "Northern Virginia Sun," a daily newspaper published at Arlington, Virginia, stated that Matthias Koehl, Jr., took command of the Party after Rockwell's assassination.

STUDENTS FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY

A source has advised that the Students for a Democratic Society (SDS), as presently regarded, came into being at a founding convention held June, 1962, at Port Huron, Michigan. From an initial posture of "participatory democracy" the line of the national leadership has revealed a growing Marxist-Leninist adherence which currently calls for the building of a revolutionary youth movement. Concurrently, the program of SDS has evolved from civil rights struggles to an anti-Vietnam war stance to an advocacy of a militant anti-imperialist position. China, Vietnam and Cuba are regarded as the leaders of worldwide struggles against United States imperialism whereas the Soviet Union is held to be revisionist and also imperialist.

At the June, 1969, SDS National Convention, Progressive Labor Party (PLP) forces in the organization were expelled. As a result, the National Office (NO) group maintained its National Headquarters at 1608 West Madison Street, Chicago, and the PLP faction set up headquarters in Cambridge, Massachusetts. This headquarters subsequently moved to Boston. Each group elected its own national officers, which include three national secretaries and a National Interim Committee of eight. Both the NO forces and the PLP forces claim to be the true SDS. Both groups also print their versions of "New Left Notes" which sets forth the line and the program of the particular faction. The NO version of "New Left Notes" was recently printed under the title "The Fire Next Time" to achieve a broader mass appeal.

Two major factions have developed internally within the NO group, namely, the Weatherman or Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM) I faction, and the RYM II faction. Weatherman is action-oriented upholding Castro's position that the duty of revolutionaries is to make revolution. Weatherman is regarded by RYM II as an adventurist, elitist faction which denies the historical role of the working class as the base for revolution. RYM II maintains that revolution, although desired, is not possible under present conditions, hence emphasizes organizi

It is a conservative student group, the successor organization to the Youth for Wallace, a group of students who supported the presidential campaign of George Wallace. It has publicly stated its position as opposing narcotics, neutralizing black power, restoration of law and order to campuses and bringing peace to the world.

For the information of Louisville, [REDACTED] has indicated that the NYA is a conservative youth movement to counter the radical student movement and the Black Power movements on American campuses and to assert the positive values of "western destiny." Allegations have been made that the NYA, or alleged members of NYA, will use violent means to combat the Students for a Democratic Society and similar organizations if college officials do not contain campus disorders attributed to such radical campus groups. Preliminary investigation is being conducted to determine if the NYA actually is promoting tactics or policy promoting use of violence.

Further, for the information of Louisville, allegations have been made that the NYA advocates a form of National Socialism or Nazism; such philosophy is set forth in a book entitled "Imperium" by FRANCIS PARKER YOCKEY (deceased) which is often described as the "bible" of the NYA. This book is a 619 page

philosophical tract extolling the virtues of a northern European civilization and warning against its adulteration by Jews, Negroes, Orientals and other "Culture distorters."

To date there has been no evidence of NYA engaging in or promoting actual acts of physical violence. It would appear that isolated incidents may have occurred, but are apparently attributable to efforts of individuals and not directly attributed to NYA policy. There has been no reliable information of a connection with the National Socialist White Peoples Party (NSWPP), formerly the American Nazi Party. In summary, investigation to date would appear that the NYA is largely a paper organization devoting its primary attention to developing revenue a substantial portion of which does not appear to have been utilized in furthering its announced objectives.

b7c Louisville should note that Bureau is not actively investigating the NYA or [REDACTED] at this point and investigation is to be limited to contacts with established sources only.

Dear Mr. Hoover:

It's been a long time since I've had occasion to write you for specific advice regarding anti-Communism--but, as I have been doing for many years now, in Arizona, Illinois, and Wisconsin, I continue to accept speaking engagements everywhere, gratis, with the purpose of exposing communism. We have more immediate concern now.

My wife and I have our three adopted children who are now teenagers being exposed to the evils of drug traffic in the schools. We have moved to our present area with the hope that there would be less danger here. However, we realize that, like disease, one cannot continue to run away from an infected area. A better choice is to build a family immunization against it--if this is at all possible. Also, we feel that our children too, have an obligation to alert others.

In recent mails our children have been receiving information and encouragement to join a youth organization called the NATIONAL YOUTH ALLIANCE. Their noted four-point program, on the surface, appears to be wholesome and patriotically American. But knowing of the many techniques of communism in its aims to influence young minds adversely, I am writing you to learn whether or no there is any reason why our children might not serve the cause of freedom by joining the NATIONAL YOUTH ALLIANCE. I'm sure you realize how important it is to keep our youth occupied in proper and positive action that will tend to conserve our heritage.

An article in the February 28, 1970, issue of the Courier-Journal, a daily Louisville, Kentucky, newspaper, reported that MICHAEL D. RUSSELL, National Field Director of the National Youth Alliance, described as a newly-formed far right group, was in Louisville, Kentucky, on February 27, 1970. According to this article, RUSSELL said the National Youth Alliance is an outgrowth of the Youth for (GEORGE) WALLACE Movement formed during the 1968 Presidential campaign. RUSSELL said that the National Youth Alliance, in addition to being anti-Marxist, also does not believe in the "equality of races" and because races are "genetically different," they should not be "forced" to mix. In addition, RUSSELL said the National Youth Alliance is attempting to "stomp out" anarchist groups on the campuses.

STUDENTS FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY

A source has advised that the Students for a Democratic Society (SDS), as presently regarded, came into being at a founding convention held June, 1962, at Port Huron, Michigan. From an initial posture of "participatory democracy" the line of the national leadership has revealed a growing Marxist-Leninist adherence which currently calls for the building of a revolutionary youth movement. Concurrently, the program of SDS has evolved from civil rights struggles to an anti-Vietnam war stance to an advocacy of a militant anti-imperialist position. China, Vietnam and Cuba are regarded as the leaders of worldwide struggles against United States imperialism whereas the Soviet Union is held to be revisionist and also imperialist.

At the June, 1969, SDS National Convention, Progressive Labor Party (PLP) forces in the organization were expelled. As a result, the National Office (NO) group maintained its National Headquarters at 1608 West Madison Street, Chicago, and the PLP faction set up headquarters in Cambridge, Massachusetts. This headquarters subsequently moved to Boston. Each group elected its own national officers, which include three national secretaries and a National Interim Committee of eight. Both the NO forces and the PLP forces claim to be the true SDS. Both groups also print their versions of "New Left Notes" which sets forth the line and the program of the particular faction. The NO version of "New Left Notes" was recently printed under the title "The Fire Next Time" to achieve a broader mass appeal.

Two major factions have developed internally within the NO group, namely, the Weatherman or Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM) I faction, and the RYM II faction. Weatherman is action-oriented upholding Castro's position that the duty of revolutionaries is to make revolution. Weatherman is regarded by RYM II as an adventurist, elitist faction which denies the historical role of the working class as the base for revolution. RYM II maintains that revolution, although desired, is not possible under present conditions, hence emphasizes organizing

and raising the political consciousness of the working class upon whom they feel successful revolution depends. Although disclaiming control and domination by the Communist Party, USA, leaders in these two factions have in the past proclaimed themselves to be communists and to follow the precepts of a Marxist-Leninist philosophy, along pro-Chinese communist lines.

A second source has advised that the PLP faction which is more commonly known as the Worker Student Alliance is dominated and controlled by members of the PIP, who are required to identify themselves with the pro-Chinese Marxist-Leninist philosophy of the PLP. They advocate that an alliance between workers and students is vital to the bringing about of a revolution in the United States.

SDS regions and university and college chapters, although operating under the outlines of the SDS National Constitution, are autonomous in nature and free to carry out independent policy reflective of local conditions. Because of this autonomy internal struggles reflecting the major factional interests of SDS have occurred at the chapter level since the beginning of the 1969-70 school year.

The PIP is characterized separately in the Appendix.

NATIONAL STATES RIGHTS PARTY (NSRP)

On November 26, 1957, a source advised that the United White Party (UWP) was organized at a convention held in Knoxville Tennessee, on November 10, 1957. An article in the November 26, 1957, issue of the "Greenville Piedmont," a newspaper of Greenville, South Carolina, reported "the recent formation of a new political party, to be known as the United White Party." According to the article, the party was formed at a recently held meeting in Knoxville, Tennessee, at which many klansmen were represented. The UWP was reported as being opposed to all "race mixing organizations and individuals."

The July, 1958, issue of "The Thunderbolt," self-described as the "official Racial Nationalist Organ of the National States Rights Party" (NSRP), reported that rank-and-file "States Righters" had merged with the UWP under "the banner of the National States Rights Party," with national offices at Post Office Box 261, Jeffersonville, Indiana.

In November, 1958, a source advised that the NSRP is composed of past members of Klan-type organizations and notorious anti-Semites.

On August 4, 1965, a source advised that Edward R. Fields, the Information Director of the NSRP and Editor of "The Thunderbolt," is the individual who actually controls the NSRP.

Issue No. 114, dated June, 1969, of "The Thunderbolt" lists Dr. Edward R. Fields as the National Director of the NSRP as well as Editor of "The Thunderbolt."

"The Thunderbolt" continues to publish articles attacking Negroes and persons of the Jewish faith.

APPENDIX

MINUTEMEN

The Minutemen, whose headquarters are in Norborne, Missouri, was organized in June, 1960, by Robert Boliver De Pugh who has been publicly identified as the National Coordinator of the organization since its inception. On September 8, 1969, he announced the appointment of his 23-year-old son, Ralph C. De Pugh, to serve in this position while he completes a one year sentence in the U. S. Penitentiary for violation of the Federal Firearms Act.

Past statements by Robert De Pugh and literature distributed by the organization indicate the purpose of the Minutemen to be the resistance to and exposure of, the spread of Communist influence within the United States; for the formation of a guerrilla or underground organization to combat the troops of any foreign powers which might eventually occupy this country; and resist passage of laws which would regulate private ownership of firearms.

A source, who in July, 1969, had access to some Minutemen records, estimated that approximately 2500 individual have in the past expressed an interest in the Minutemen and have been considered as members by De Pugh; however, source believes there are probably no more than 300 actual active members of the organization. A second source in October, 1969, advised that the Minutemen tend to grossly exaggerate the number of their members. The source estimated the actual membership to be no more than possibly 350 members.

In April, 1966, De Pugh, in his book, "Blueprint For Victory", wrote the Minutemen organization was then dividing into two bodies; the Minutemen and the Patriotic Party. One group, the Minutemen, would be the resistance movement and the other, the Patriotic Party, whose proper function would be to serve as the political arm of a complete patriotic resistance movement.

Members of the Minutemen organization, including Robert De Pugh and his chief assistant, Walter P. Peyson, have been a

rested in the past on charges of violations of the Federal Firearms Act, Bank Robbery-Conspiracy, Illegal Possession of Firearms and Conspiracy to Commit Arson. They have also engaged in maneuvers utilizing guerrilla tactics, wherein machine guns, mortars, grenades, and other firearms were employed.

PROGRESSIVE LABOR PARTY (PLP)

"The New York Times" city edition, Tuesday, April 20, 1965, page 27, reported that a new party of "revolutionary socialism" was formally founded on April 18, 1965, under the name of the PLP which had been known as the Progressive Labor Movement.

According to the article, "The Progressive Labor Movement was founded in 1962, by Milton Rosen and Mortimer Scheer after they were expelled from the Communist Party of the United States for assertedly following the Chinese Communist line."

A source advised on June 3, 1968, that the PLP held its Second National Convention in New York City, May 31 to June 2, 1968, at which time the PLP reasserted its objective of the establishment of a militant working class movement based on Marxism-Leninism. This is to be accomplished through the Party's over-all revolutionary strategy of raising the consciousness of the people and helping to provide ideological leadership in the working class struggle for state power.


The source also advised that at the Second National Convention Milton Rosen was unanimously re-elected National Chairman of the PLP and Levi Laub, Fred Jerome, Jared Israel, William Epton, Jacob Rosen, Jeffrey Gordon, and Walter Linder were elected as the National Committee to lead the PLP until the next convention.

The PLP publishes "Progressive Labor," a bimonthly magazine; "World Revolution," a quarterly periodical; and "Challenge-Desafio," a monthly newspaper.

The April, 1969, issue of "Challenge-Desafio" sets forth that "Challenge is dedicated to the peoples fight for a new way of life--where the working men and women control their own homes and factories; where they themselves make up the entire government on every level and control the schools, courts, police and all institutions which are now used to control them."

PROGRESSIVE LABOR PARTY (PLP)

Source advised on May 8, 1969, that the PLP utilizes an address of General Post Office Box 808, Brooklyn, New York, and also utilizes an office in Room 617, 1 Union Square West, New York, New York.

For the information of the Bureau, WFO has noted a trend by the NYA in recent months toward a more extreme "rightist", anti-Jewish posture. This trend has been evidenced by BYERS' appearance as a "principal" speaker at the National States Rights Party Convention at Newport, Kentucky, in June, 1970; the anti-Semitic character of recent NYA publications; and control of certain NYA activities by NSWPP supporters. The most notable example of the latter condition is the NYA chapter at St. John's University, New York City, which was found to be dominated by NSWPP supporters when its character as a legitimate campus organization was questioned recently by student government representatives.

The enclosed LHM is being disseminated by WFO locally to Secret Service and interested military intelligence agencies.

Rightists Open New Offices

The right-wing National Youth Alliance reorganized and revitalized in part by defectors from the old American Nazi Party, has opened new offices in Georgetown with a bookstore for anti-Zionists, scientific racism and other ideologies of the right.

"It's sort of the hub of youth in D.C.," the new NYA national organizer, Robert A. Lloyd, said, of Georgetown, noted for its posh boutiques, youth culture and fashionable restored homes.

"We're here because we

don't want to be squeezed away from the youth of the country," Lloyd said.

Formed in the spring of 1969 from the remains of the Youth For Wallace movement in the 1968 presidential campaign, NYA opened a new near Dupont Circle, and a popular alpine meeting place.

It outgrew its available space there, according to leaders, and the move to 1856 Wisconsin Ave. NW in Georgetown was made.

The new location includes a "Western Destiny" bookstore, which carries a broad selection of philosophical

and political tracts, anthropological treatises on white or Aryan superiority, and assorted books alleging a Zionist conspiracy to undermine Western civilization, and other publications.

The store's best-seller is "Imperialism" by Francis Parker Yockey. It is a weighty treatise warning of the impending demise of Western civilization unless the influence of "culture distorters," mainly Jews, Negroes, Orientals and others, is removed.

Right-Wing Youth Organization Opens New Office in Georgetown

A portion of the bookstore's inventory, according to Lloyd, comes from the now closed bookstore of the National Socialist White Peoples Party (formerly the American Nazi Party) in Arlington.

Lloyd himself was executive officer of the NSWPP but quit during a recent party split and joined NYA. He became national organizer, succeeding Louis T. Byers, who was elevated to

the newly created position of NYA president. Another ex-NSWPP member, writer William Pierce, is also an NYA friend, Byers said, but is not on the payroll.

Since early 1969, Byers and a small staff have been organizing NYA chapters on college campuses across the country to fight drugs, black militancy and left-wing radicalism, with force when deemed necessary.

He claims now to have more than 2,000 members with a large portion of them

organized into 62 campus chapters, ranging from the University of Chicago and New York University to Kent State University in Ohio.

Working with a 25,000-member mailing list for financial support, NYA has rapidly increased its administrative workload in the last year and will at least double its present staff of four in the next few months, Byers said.

The bookstore now has about 300 titles and will expand to 500 soon, Lloyd said.

On May 26, 1970, a source who has furnished reliable information in the past advised that the American Nazi Party - World Union of Free Enterprise National Socialists (ANP-WUFENS) was organized by George Lincoln Rockwell at Arlington, Virginia, on February 26, 1959. It was based upon the concept of an international "National Socialist" movement, as espoused by the German Nazi Party, which was headed by Adolf Hitler. The ANP-WUFENS supports and follows the line of hatred against Negroes, Jews, and communists, through speeches, published literature, demonstrations and publicity-seeking devices for the purpose of seeking a legitimate dominant political party within the United States and foreign countries.

"The Richmond News Leader" issue dated April 4, 1963, published daily at Richmond, Virginia, stated that this organization is chartered in the State of Virginia as "The George Lincoln Rockwell Party" and that the Virginia Assembly prohibits the use of "Nazi" or "National Socialism" in a Virginia-chartered organization. As of January 1, 1967, the official name of this organization was changed to "National Socialist White People's Party," according to Commander Rockwell.

On August 25, 1967, George Lincoln Rockwell was assassinated in Arlington, Virginia, near the ANP Headquarters Building. The August 28, 1967, issue of the "Northern Virginia Sun," a daily newspaper published at Arlington, Virginia, stated that Matthias Koehl, Jr., took command of the Party after Rockwell's assassination. This source advised that the organization continues with its aims and goals mentioned above.

included a "Western Destiny" bookstore stocked with about 300 different works. It was noted that the new location was selected because of its proximity to the Washington youth culture.

"The Washington Post" article mentioned above states that Byers claimed a membership of 8,000 in the NYA "with a large portion of them organized into 62 campus chapters, ranging from the University of Chicago and New York University to Kent State University in Ohio". The article claimed the NYA worked with a 24,400-member mailing list for financial support".

On December 24, 1970, "The Evening Star", a daily newspaper published at WDC, reported the opening of the "Western Destiny Bookshop" in Georgetown on December 21, 1970. The "Star" article stated that the bookshop was sponsored by the "International Youth Alliance, a far-right youth group centered in Arlington (Virginia)". Charles McGuire was identified in the article as office manager of the International Youth Alliance and Earl Thomas was identified as McGuire's assistant.

The ANP-WUFENS supports and follows the line of hatred against Negroes, Jews, and communists, through speeches, published literature, demonstrations and publicity-seeking devices for the purpose of seeking a legitimate dominant political party within the United States and foreign countries.

"The Richmond News Leader" issue dated April 4, 1963, published daily at Richmond, Virginia, stated that this organization is chartered in the State of Virginia as "The George Lincoln Rockwell Party" and that the Virginia Assembly prohibits the use of "Nazi" or "National Socialism" in a Virginia-chartered organization. As of January 1, 1967, the official name of this organization was changed to "National Socialist White People's Party," according to Commander Rockwell.

On August 25, 1967, George Lincoln Rockwell was assassinated in Arlington, Virginia, near the ANP Headquarters Building. The August 28, 1967, issue of the "Northern Virginia Sun," a daily newspaper published at Arlington, Virginia, stated that Matthias Koehl, Jr., took command of the Party after Rockwell's assassination. This source advised that the organization continues with its aims and goals mentioned above.





As noted in referenced LHM, Washington, D. C. newspapers in December, 1970, reported the reorganization of the National Youth Alliance (NYA) and its relocation in the Georgetown Section of Washington, D. C., at 1656 Wisconsin Avenue, N.W. (now 1656 33rd Street, N.W.), from 813 Dupont Circle Building, Washington, D. C. According to these reports, the new NYA Headquarters includes a Western Destiny Bookstore, which is stocked with a broad selection of works on white or Aryan superiority and the alleged "Zionist conspiracy."

The above newspaper reports reflect that LOUIS T. BYERS, former National Organizer of the NYA, had been elevated to President in the new NYA organization and ROBERT A. LLOYD had become the new National Organizer. LLOYD is identified in these articles as the former Executive Officer of the National Socialist White People's Party (NSWPP) of Arlington, Virginia (formerly the American Nazi Party). CHARLES H. MC GUIRE, according to these articles, is office manager of the NYA offices in Washington, D. C., and EARL THOMAS is an assistant to MC GUIRE. Dr. WILLIAM L. PIERCE (former Information Officer of the NSWPP) is mentioned in the articles as an "NYA friend" but reportedly is not on the payroll.

We want to hit as many major areas as possible with our organizing campaign before schools are out for the summer.

After a delay of nearly fifty days, our printer has finally delivered to us a new supply of Dr. Oliver's brilliant article, "After Fifty Years." While they last, you may have 10 copies for one dollar.

Equipment Still Needed

The National Office could get more work done faster—and save money, too—if we had a few items of equipment we cannot afford to purchase at this time. Presently on our "want list" are:

- A good, dependable mimeograph or other office duplicator. We now must have all our form letters sent out for printing, which means expense and delay which could be avoided.

- A postage postal scale with a capacity of 50 pounds. Believe it or not, good postal scales cost over \$100, but we really need one to cut out the guesswork in our mailing department.

NOTES

- A used but serviceable station wagon or light delivery van. Trying to haul dozens of heavy mail sacks to the post office in a light passenger car is an aggravating nuisance. With a vehicle better suited for the purpose we could cut our postal runs through Washington's ungodly traffic to one each day.

Be an ATTACK! Reporter!

For most of the background material used in writing ATTACK!, we are dependent on the System press. Yet much of the most interesting news never comes to our attention, because, although it is

reported in local newspapers where it appears, it is killed by the major wire services and never appears in the Washington newspapers.

Every NYA member can be an ATTACK! reporter if he will clip interesting news items from his local newspaper and send them to us. Especially useful are good press photos. Be careful not to underline or otherwise mark up clip and photos you send us, because sometimes we want to reproduce them photographically. If you want to call attention to something in a clipping to our attention, make a mark in the margin.

Send ACTION News

Whenever any NYA member or Unit carries out any local activity which is at all newsworthy, it should be reported to the National Office. Be sure to send us at least one complete set of clippings of any local newspaper coverage.

Thanks to Our Pledgers

The entire National Office staff wants it to be known that the fact that NYA is still alive and kicking is due to a relative handful of dedicated Americans who have recently become monthly NYA pledgers. Without their selfless devotion to our cause, we simply wouldn't be able to pay our bills and keep the doors open here.

There are only a few hundred of them at this time—mighty few shoulders to bear so much of the burden. But the support which comes in each month from our pledgers is what makes the difference.
