The National States Rights Party (NSRP), formerly known as the United White Party, was organized in 1957 at Knoxville, Tennessee, and is based upon the concept of being opposed to all "race mixing organizations and individuals." The July, 1958, issue of "The Thunderbolt," self-described as the "official racial nationalist organ of the NSRP," reported that rank and file "States Righters" had merged with the United White Party under "The banner of the NSRP." The organization supports and follows its official line of hatred against the Jews, Negroes, communists, and certain law enforcement agencies, especially the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The organization carries out its line of hatred through the use of propaganda media and provocative demonstrations.

The national leaders of the NSRP have repeatedly and publicly urged the expulsion of all Jews and Negroes from the United States. ON September 1, 1968, following an NSRP rally at Berea, Kentucky, members of the NSRP and members of the local Negro community engaged in a gunfight in which one member of the NSRP and one Negro male were killed. The gunfight, which ensued following the rally, was attributed to anti-Negro remarks made by leaders of the NSRP at the rally.

The leaders of the NSRP travel extensively throughout the United States and utilize interstate communications in the furtherance of their activities.

The Minuteman organization was organized in 1960, reportedly to resist the spread of communism in the United States by use of guerrilla tactics. ROBERT B. DePUGH, national coordinator of the Minutemen, was sentenced in October, 1970, for violations of the Federal Firearms Act. At the time of his arrest, DePUGH was in possession of documents concerned with guerrilla warfare and other paraphernalia, including hand grenades, gun silencers, and a machine gun. De PUGH was released on parole during April, 1973, and in June, 1973, indicated he plans to revitalize the Minutemen into a "two-armed organization." Arm Number one will be a political front organization, the purpose of which will be to sway elections and control local and state political structures. Arm Number two will be an underground guerrilla organization made up of "strike teams." These "strike teams" are to be under the direct control of DePUGH and their existence is to be unknown to everyone including Minutemen State Coordinators.

Wallace supporters following the 1968 Presidential election for the purpose of countering radical leftist and anarchist influences on the campuses of American colleges and universities. NYA currently is controlled by individuals who militantly promote white racialism and anti-Zionism and who suggest violent revolution ultimately as the means for implementing their racial and political ideas in America.

The February, 1974 (Number 25) issue of "Attack!", the tabloid newspaper published by NYA, announced the formation of a new organization called the National Alliance (NA). The new organization was described in "Attack!" as a "super structure for an anticipated array of specialized, coordinate groups" of which NYA will continue as the youth group for individuals thirty years of age and under. Persons over thirty years of age wishing to join the "movement" must become members of the new organization. Enclosed for the Bureau are five copies of the July, 1974, (No. 28), issue of "Attack!", tabloid newspaper published by the National Youth Alliance (NYA), extremist white youth organization with headquarters at Washington, D. C. (WDC).

For the information of the Bureau, the lead article in the current issue of "Attack!", entitled "'Super-K' Is a Phony", alleges that Secretary of State HENRY KISSINGER's reputation as a brilliant statesman based up on his reported diplomatic successes in Vietnam and the Middle East is a "media-managed myth" and that KISSINGER's diplomacy in these areas has cost the United States dearly in terms of compromise and concessions.

The current "Attack!" editorial, entitled "Watergate and Democracy", is addressed to current supporters of President NIXON who "consider the President an innocent victim of a conspiracy by the media and the liberals in the Congress to get rid of him." The editorial acknowledges the media-liberal campaign to hound President NIXON from office, but castigates NIXON supporters for closing their eyes to the fact that he "is guilty of the great majority of the things of which he is being accused by the media and the liberals". It contends that NIXON supporters should not out of hatred for the President's enemies, ignore evidence that he "is a thief, a liar, and a suborner of perjurers", and that his disastrous economic and social policies, his political conniving and his compromises with the Jews prove him also to be a traitor to the people. The editorial concludes that if there is any redeeming value in the Watergate mess, it is an awakening of the American

people to the fact that corruption begets criminals and that "there is no way to put an honest man into the White House- or to begin healing America's hastening ills-while the System remains intact".

A feature article in the current issue of "Attack!" entitled "Spiro and the Jews" cites "The Times of Israel", reportedly an English-language Zionist publication for Americans, as the source of an allegation that JEWS had promoted former Vice President SPIRO T. AGNEW from an obscure Baltimore County politician to Vice President and that Jews were responsible for pulling him down. The article names individual Jews among AGNEW's former aides, staff and associates during his political rise to the Vice Presidency and asserts that "it was AGNEW's Jewish business associates, working with two Jewish prosecutors in the U. S. Attorney's office in Baltimore, who pulled him down".

Another feature article consisting of two pages, including photographs, is captioned "Remember the Liberty!" and recounts the Israeli air and naval attack on the United States' communications ship, "U. S. S. Liberty", on 6/8/67 off the Sinai Peninsula. A two-page article entitled "The Masters of the Media" appears to be a rehash of previous "Attack!" articles which allege and purport to prove that the public information media is controlled by Jews and is insidiously used to promote Jewish interests.

"The Movement in Action", a feature devoted to the activities of individuals involved in promoting the right-wing movement, contains items with photographs pertaining to a demonstration held on 6/8/74 in WDC to commemorate the anniversary of the Israeli attack on the "U.S.S. Liberty" and the introduction of newspaper vending machines by the National Youth Alliance in the Washington area to increase the distribution of "Attack!". This feature also notes the candidacy of J. B. STONER, chairman of the National States Rights Party, for the office of Lieutenant Governor of Georgia and notes the similarity of his racial and political views to those of the National Youth Alliance.


