ON FRIDAY, APRIL 10, 1987, [REDACTED] RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SAID HE HOPED [REDACTED] COULD HELP HIM AND A FRIEND. THE INDIVIDUAL WENT ON TO EXPLAIN THAT HE AND A FRIEND WERE US MARINES IN VIETNAM WHEN THEY WERE CAPTURED BY ENEMY FORCES IN 1964. THEY RETURNED TO THE US IN 1979-1980 AND HAD SINCE BEEN LIVING UNDER ASSUMED IDENTITIES. BOTH FELT IT WAS TIME TO RESURFACE AND REQUESTED [REDACTED] HELP IN MAKING THE APPROPRIATE CONTACTS WITH THE PRESS AND THE DOD.

[REDACTED] STATED THAT THEIR CONCERN WAS APPARENTLY FOUNDED IN THE BELIEF THAT ROBERT GARWOOD, A FORMER VIETNAM POW CHARGED WITH COLLABORATING WITH THE ENEMY, KNOWS OF THEIR ACTIONS IN VIETNAM AND IS LIKELY TO REVEAL THIS INFORMATION IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

[REDACTED] IDENTIFIED THE FORMER MARINES AS (FIRST NAME UNKNOWN) (FNU) [REDACTED] AND FNJ [REDACTED] (PHONETIC). (REFERENCED BUREAU TELETYPE IDENTIFIED THE MISSING SERVICEMEN AS

[REDACTED] HE DESCRIBED [REDACTED] AS WHITE MALES, BOTH OF WHOM NOW WEAR BEARDS AND ARE PRESUMED LIVING IN THE SOUTHERN US. [REDACTED] SAID HE HAS NO TELEPHONE NUMBER OR POINT OF CONTACT FOR EITHER. *EO 12812-2 b2c*

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APRIL 20, 1987, AND DIA HAD PRESUMABLY NOTIFIED THE PUBLIC AFFAIRS OFFICE OF ITS ROLE IN THE MATTER. [REDACTED] MET WITH [REDACTED] ON MONDAY, APRIL 20, 1987, AT WHICH TIME HE ACCOMPANIED THEM TO A BUILDING HOUSING LAW OFFICES LOCATED AT 1345 SIXTH AVENUE, NEW YORK CITY. ARKIN ADVISED THAT HE DROPPED THEM OFF AT THE BUILDING AND RETURNED HOME. LATER THAT DAY, [REDACTED] RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS

[REDACTED] (LAST NAME UNKNOWN) (LNU), AND SAID HE WAS ACTING AS THE ATTORNEY FOR [REDACTED] HE ALSO TOLD [REDACTED] THAT HIS SERVICES WOULD NO LONGER BE NEEDED IN THIS MATTER.


